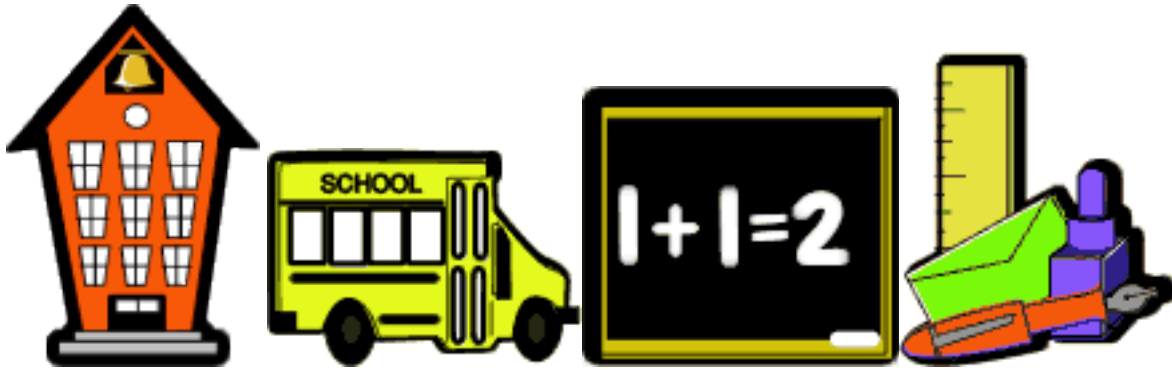

SCHOOL CLOSINGS

Should severe weather require the closing of school, or a late start, the Honeywell Instant Alert notification system will be utilized, and is the primary means of notification by the district. An alert will be sent to either your home phone number, OR the primary phone number you have registered with the district. If you wish to receive notification using other devices (cell phone, email, etc.), you must update your profile by logging into the Honeywell Instant Alert website: <https://instantalert.honeywell.com>. The instructions to update your profile are on the district website, as well as a link to access the Instant Alert website. You can log onto your profile at any time to update your contact information. Maintaining the accuracy of your profile will increase the ability of the school to keep you informed.

FROM THE NURSE-EMERGENCY INFORMATION

The school office maintains a record of emergency information and contacts on all students. Most forms were filled out at the beginning of the year. It is not unusual for emergency information to change. If your child's emergency information has changed please be sure to let the office know so that we can update our records.
