ICT AFTER SCHOOL WORKSHOPS

- Semester 2 2010 ICT Workshops run after school every second Tuesday Afternoon. Up to 15 staff in attendance each workshop with accreditation through MYPL provided.

DER GRANT

- End 2010 successful application for DER funding of \$5000.

DER IN YEAR 11 2011

- 35 teachers who were timetabled to teach Year 11 in 2010 spent the last teaching day for year as a student in a Moodle Course.
- Course included: videos on 21st Century Learning, Class Agreements using Choice Activity, Web Tools, Glossaries, starting the year with a student Questionnaire, Teachers used Wiki's, Blogs, Forums and Chat in Moodle, Prezi, eAssessment (Tight, Loose, Tight), PLN (Personal Learning Network), Smart Notebook and did Evaluation online using Moodle Questionnaire Activity.
- Casual release paid for by DER Grant.

DER LEADERS

- Teachers were asked to nominate to be a DER Leader at Cronulla High School.
- Idea was to ensure that grant benefitted the whole school and not just a specific faculty. This was possible because of how mature our Technology Program was.
- Leaders given Logitech M305 Wireless Mouse to trial in classrooms paid for by the Principal.

TECHNOLOGY AUDIT 2011

- DER Grant allowed for DER Leaders to be released to examine with me the specific needs for their faculty.
- This information was documented and a plan for using DER Grant to fund this work was devised.
- DER Leaders then implemented the plans spending lots of time at School and in the Teachers own time.

DER 2011

- Great machine unfortunately it makes the S1 and S2 look bad.



STAFF DEVELOPMENT DAY

TERM 2

- DER Leaders ran sessions with their colleagues to train teachers and complete the tasks identified by the DER Audit. Evaluations were conducted and comments were very positive. Some teachers said that it was the most useful SDD they have ever participated in.

TECHNOLOGY IN CLASSROOM

- With the assistance of the P&C and faculty budgets a program to install 7 new Ultra Short Throw Projectors was undertaken in Term 2.
- We are down to just 6 classrooms that don't have fixed technology installations but some of these are serviced by portable devices.



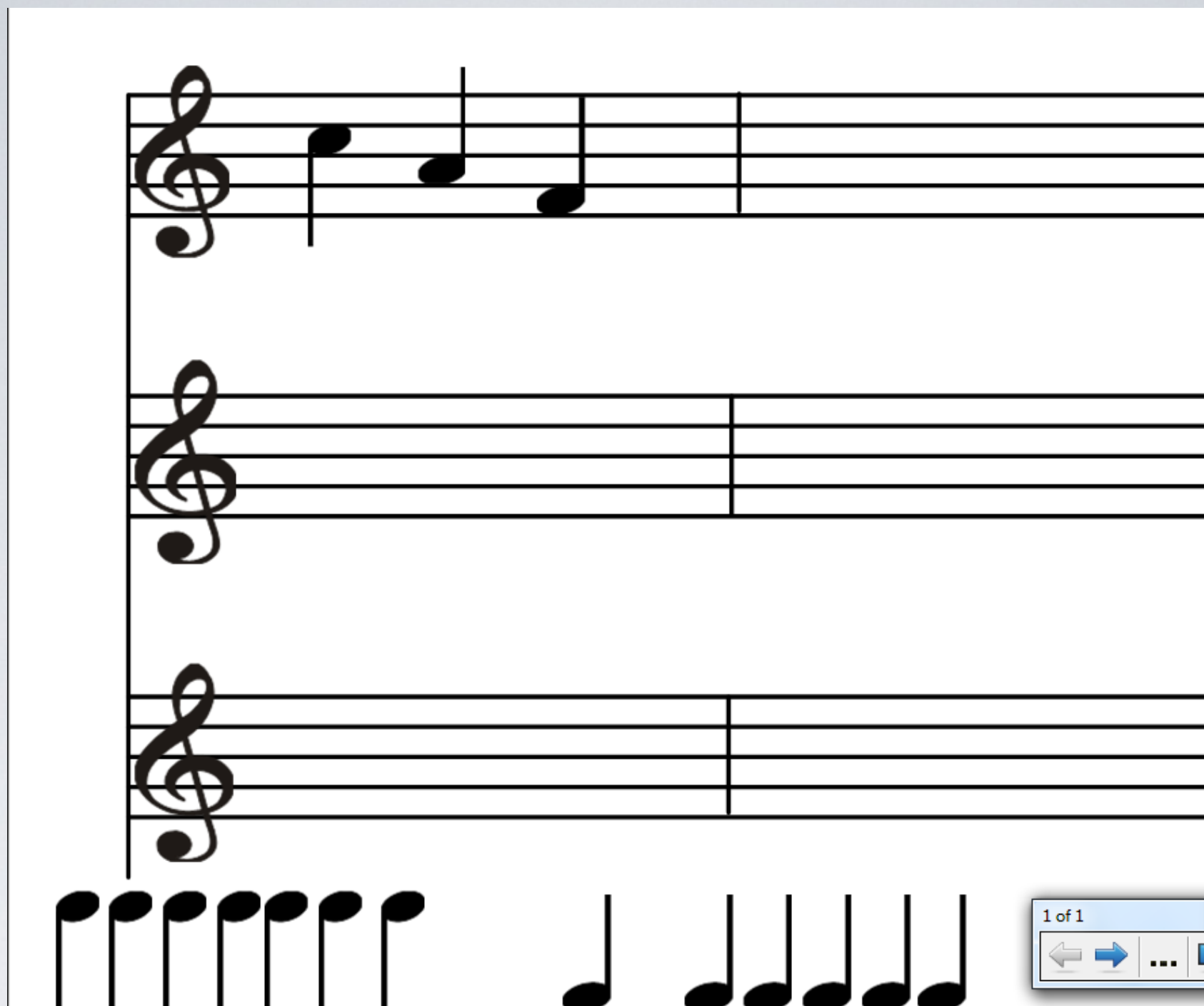

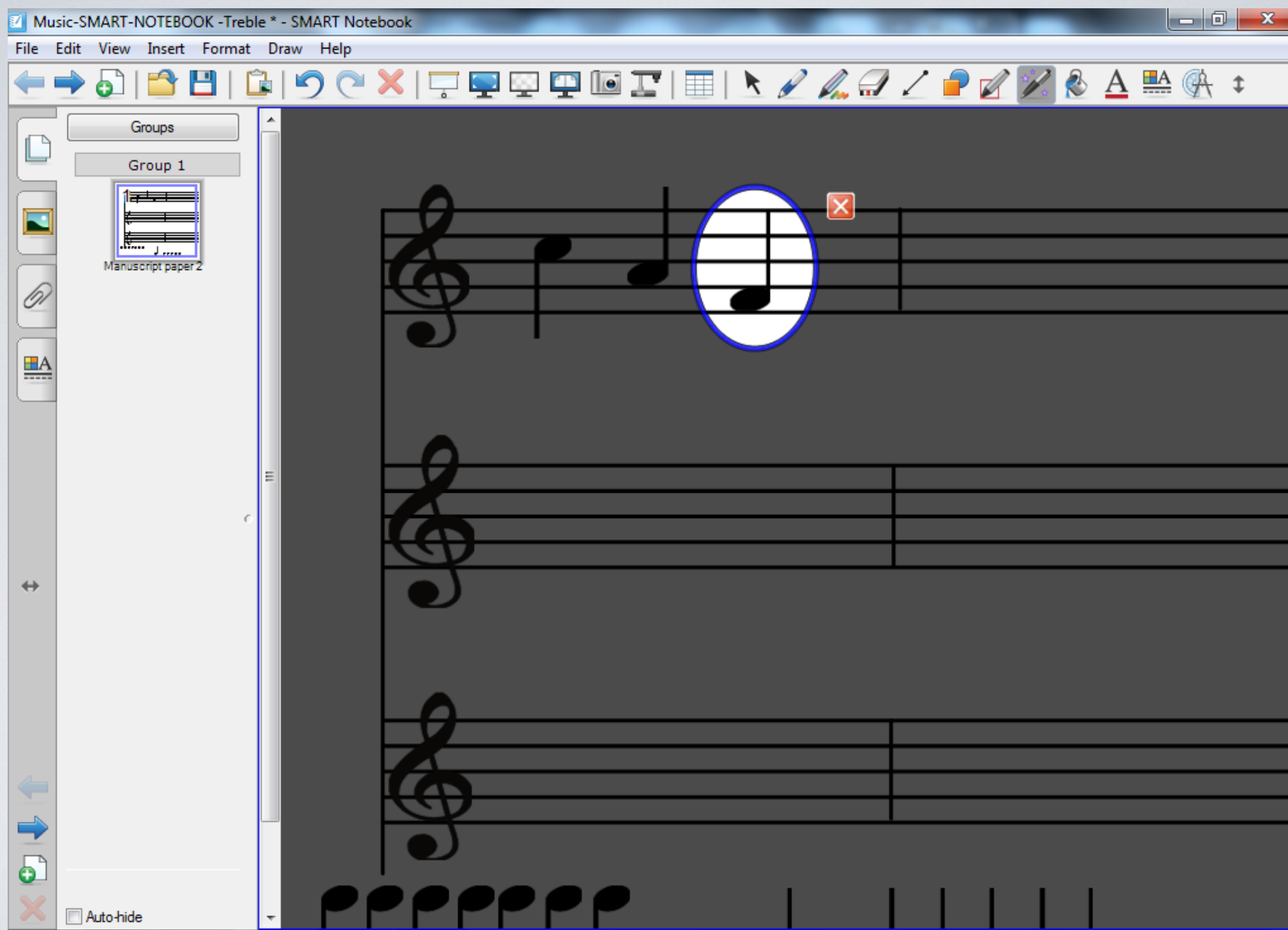

Unity

The composer **creates unity** by **restating musical ideas**. The listener is therefore given the opportunity to become accustomed to the music. With familiarity comes the ability to anticipate musical occurrences, and a sense of satisfaction is felt by the fulfilment of musical expectations. It also helps to maintain listener interest.

With too much repetition the *familiarity breeds contempt*. To the listener, relentless repetition becomes tiresome and creates the negative effect of monotony. If, however, some form of variety is added to the repetition, the listener's interest is maintained when expectations are met with surprise.

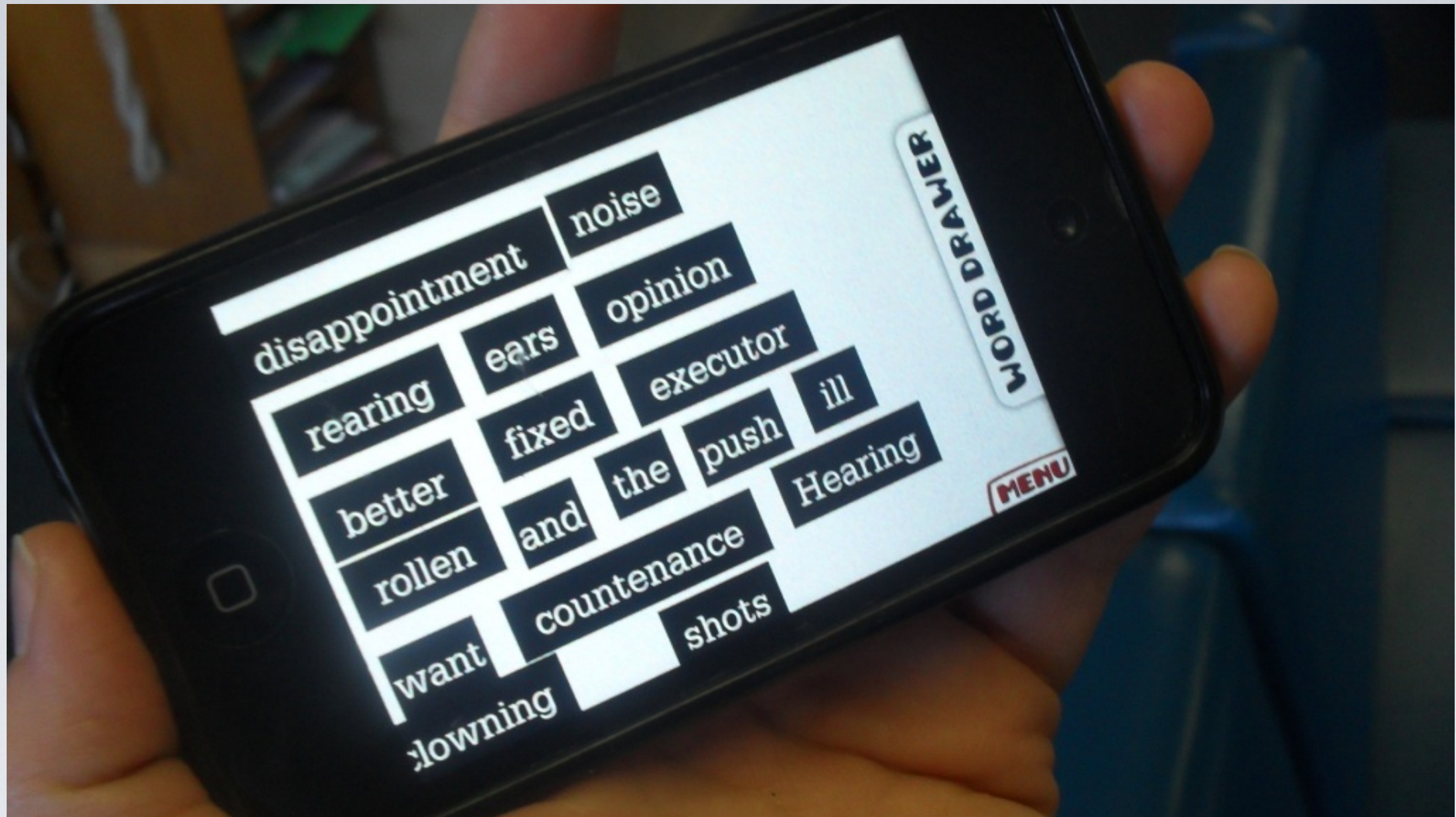

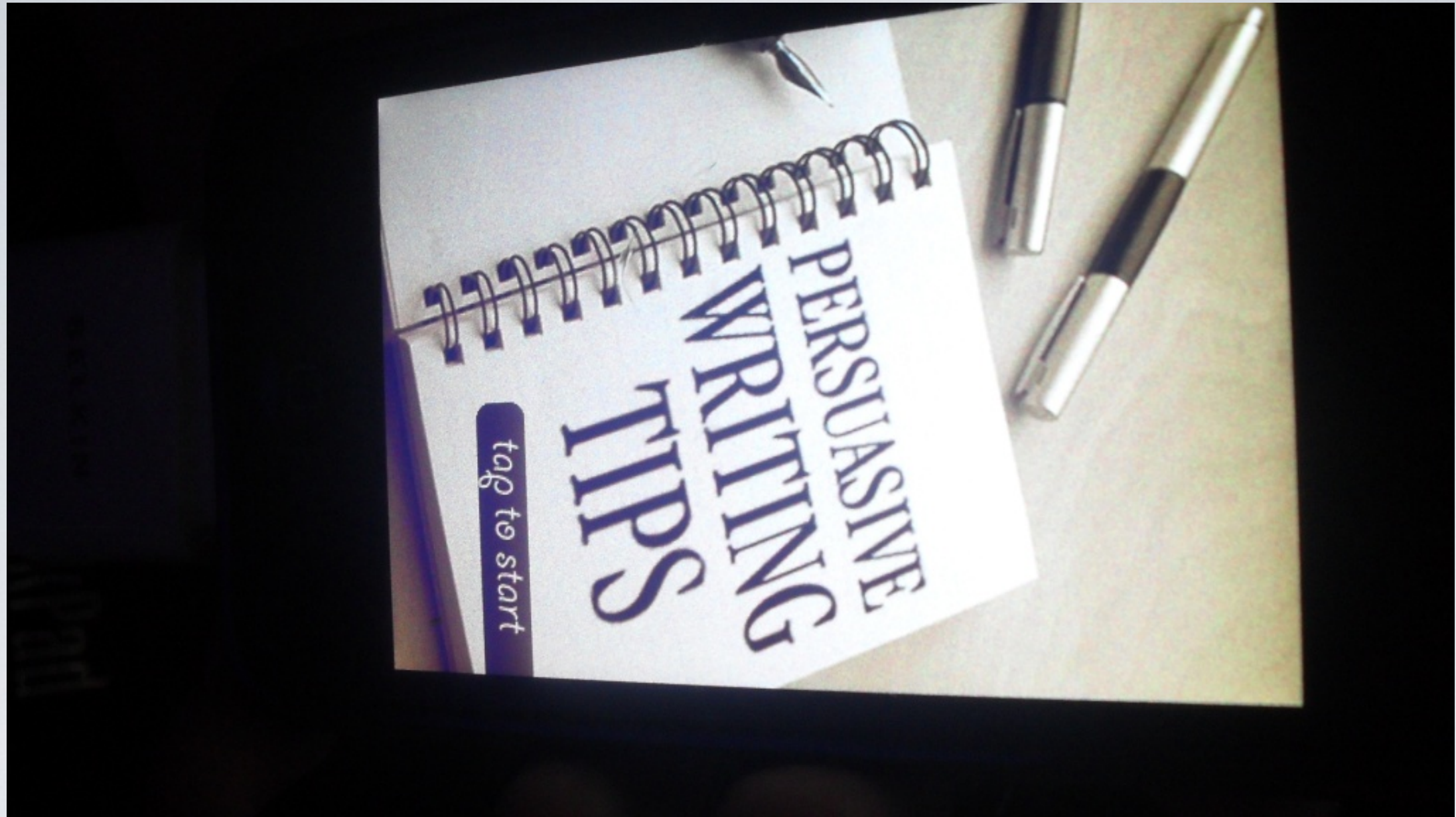

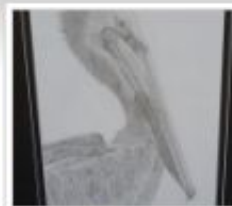
