### New Update Alert

The following 6799 new updates have been synchronized to WSUS since Wednesday, November 16, 2011 5:29 PM (GMT).

### Critical and Security Updates

#### [Critical Update, November 19, 2001](#)

This update resolves the "You May Lose Data or Program Settings After Reinstalling, Repairing, or Upgrading Windows XP" issue in Windows XP, and is discussed in Microsoft Knowledge Base (KB) Article Q312369. If you upgrade, reinstall, or repair the version of Windows XP that was preinstalled by a computer manufacturer, in some cases, you might lose data or program settings. Download now to ensure that you do not lose data or settings in Windows XP.

#### [Remote Assistance Connection](#)

This update resolves the "Cannot Establish a Remote Assistance Connection" issue in Windows XP, and is discussed in Microsoft Knowledge Base (KB) Article 311889. When you try to establish a Remote Assistance session, you might receive an error message, and be unable to start a Remote Assistance session. Download now to ensure that you can establish a Remote Assistance session successfully. This item has been updated since it was released in October, 2001. If you have already installed this item, it is not necessary to reinstall it.

#### [Security Update, December 17, 2001](#)

This update resolves the "Unchecked Buffer in Universal Plug and Play Can Lead to System Compromise" security vulnerability in Windows XP. Download now to help prevent a malicious user from compromising your computer or using your computer to compromise another computer's functionality.

#### [Critical Update, February 10, 2002](#)

This update addresses the "Stop 0xED on mounting volume on IDE drives" issue in Windows XP, and is discussed in Microsoft Knowledge Base (KB) Article Q315403. Download now to resolve an issue affecting computers with IDE hard drives with caching enabled, that prevents the chkdisk.exe utility from running when your computer restarts.

#### [Security Update, February 12, 2002](#)

This update resolves the "Unchecked Buffer in SNMP Service Could Enable Arbitrary Code to be Run" security vulnerability in Windows XP, and is discussed in Microsoft Security Bulletin MS02-006. Download now to help prevent a malicious user from running code of his or her choice or launching a denial of service (DoS) attack on your computer.

### **System Recovered Error Message Update**

This update addresses the "'System has recovered from a serious error' message appears after every reboot" issue in Windows XP, and is discussed in Microsoft Knowledge Base (KB) Article Q317277. Download now to prevent the error message "System has recovered from a serious error" from appearing each time your computer starts.

### **Security Update, February 13, 2002 (MSXML 4.0)**

This update resolves the "XMLHTTP Control Can Allow Access to Local Files" security vulnerability in Microsoft XML (MSXML) 4.0 and is discussed in Microsoft Security Bulletin MS02-008. Download now to help prevent a malicious user from reading the files on your computer when you visit a specially malformed Web site.

### **Q329048: Security Update**

This update resolves the "Unchecked Buffer in File Decompression Functions" security vulnerability in Windows XP. Download now to help prevent a specially malformed file from causing unauthorized code to run on your computer.

### **Security Update (326886)**

This update resolves the "Flaw in Network Connection Manager" security vulnerability in Windows 2000. Download now to help prevent a malicious user from gaining elevated privileges through the Network Connection Manager, and then running code of his or her choice on your computer.

### **Q324096: Security Update (Windows XP)**

This update resolves the "Buffer Overrun in SmartHTML Interpreter Could Allow Code Execution" vulnerability in Windows XP. Download now to eliminate a vulnerability of moderate severity in the Front Page 2000 Server Extensions for Microsoft Office.

### **Q327696: Internet Information Services Security Roll-up Package**

This update addresses several newly discovered security vulnerabilities affecting Internet Information Services (IIS) 5.1 with Windows XP Professional, as well as incorporating all previous updates for IIS. Download now help protect the security of your computer.

### **Q329414: Security Update (MDAC 2.5)**

This security update applies to a component of Windows known as the Microsoft Data Access Component (MDAC). Please install now to help protect your Windows-based computer. For more information, read the associated Microsoft Security Bulletin at <http://www.microsoft.com/security>.

### **Q329414: Security Update (MDAC 2.6)**

### **Security Update, February 13, 2002 (MSXML 3.0)**

This update resolves the "XMLHTTP Control Can Allow Access to Local Files" security vulnerability in Microsoft XML (MSXML) 3.0 and is discussed in Microsoft Security Bulletin MS02-006. Download now to help prevent a malicious user from reading the files on your computer when you visit a specially malformed Web site.

### **Q329390: Security Update**

An identified security vulnerability in Windows XP could enable an attacker to compromise a user's

Microsoft® Windows®-based computer and gain complete control over it, if the user visited the attacker's web site or took other, less likely, actions. You can help protect your computer from this and other identified security concerns by installing this update. After you install this item, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **Q329553: Critical Update (Windows 2000)**

Because of code changes and improvements to Windows Update, you may be unable to obtain the latest device driver updates using Windows Device Manager and Add Printer Wizard components. To resolve this issue, you must update the Code Download Manager (CDM), a component on your computer that interacts with Windows Update. Download now to get the latest version of CDM. After you install this item, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **Q329115: Security Update (Windows XP)**

This update resolves the "Certificate Validation Flaw Could Enable Identity Spoofing" vulnerability in Windows XP. Download now to help prevent an attacker from attempting identity spoofing using certificates. After you install this item, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **Q328310: Security Update (Windows 2000)**

A security vulnerability has been identified that could allow an attacker to compromise a Windows-based computer and gain complete control over it. The attacker would need the ability to log onto the computer to carry out an attack. You can help protect your computer from this specific vulnerability by installing this update from Microsoft. After you install this update, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **811630: Critical Update (Windows XP)**

This update enables applications to access HTML Help in a new, restricted mode. Future updates of Internet Explorer require this new capability. Download now to ensure that Internet Explorer can properly display HTML Help in HTML pages.

#### **810577: Security Update**

A security issue has been identified that could allow an attacker to compromise a computer running Microsoft(r) Windows(r) XP and gain control over it. To attempt an attack, the attacker would have to be able to log on to the computer. You can help protect your computer by installing this update from Microsoft. After you install this item, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **814033: Critical Update**

This update addresses the "Offered driver may not install using Windows Update" issue in Windows XP, and is discussed in Microsoft Knowledge Base (KB) Article 814033. Download now so you can download drivers that Windows Update offers. After installing this update, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **813951: Update for Internet Explorer 6 SP1**

This update fixes an issue caused by Internet Explorer security patch 810847 that can cause authentication issues in Internet Explorer. Download now to avoid continuous authentication requests. After installing this item, you may have to restart your computer. Once you install this update, it cannot be removed.

#### **814078: Security Update (Microsoft Jscript version 5.1, Windows 2000)**

A security issue has been identified that could allow an attacker to run programs on a computer running Microsoft® Windows®. The attacker would first have to send you an e-mail message or entice you into visiting a malicious Web site. You can help protect your computer by installing this update from Microsoft. After you install this item, you may have to restart your computer. Once you have installed this item, it cannot be removed.
