

Template for Cubing

A cube includes 6 commands-one on each of it's six faces-followed by a prompt that describes the task the students should do related to the command.

Command: Describe

Prompt: Describe the rainforest using as much info as you can, and involving as many of your senses as possible in your description.

Describe It!	What is your topic? Describe or define it.
Compare It!	What is your topic similar to and different from?
Associate It!	What does your topic remind you of?
Analyze It!	How can you break your topic down? How are those pieces related?
Apply It!	How can your topic be applied? What can you do with it? How can it be used?
Argue for it or Argue Against it?	Why are you in favor of it or against it? Why would others be in favor of it or against it?
