






Make a Photo Album in Power Point.

Open Power Point.


- Click insert
- Photo Album
- New album
- Click File/Disk
- Browse to find file
- If you want all the photos in the folder you can ctrl A to select all or by holding down the ctrl key you can insert the photos you choose.
- Click Insert
- You have an option to choose all pictures black and white
- You can browse to choose a theme
- Create
- You now have a photo album that you can customise to your liking.
- Click Slide Show
- Set up Slide Show
- You can choose various options .e.g. Loop continuously. OK



- To add music: Click insert and choose option. If it is a file browse to find the file and click Open. Choose to play automatically or when clicked.
- Click Animations
- Custom animation
- You will see a box like this on the right side of the screen. Right click and click on Effect Options or Double click this box.



- You can choose how you want the music to play and stop e.g. after 14 slides
- You can choose a transition scheme
- You can choose how to advance to next slide:
- If you want Automatically make sure that On Mouse Click is turned off and choose a time.g.00.02 and apply to all.
- Save
- Press F5 and play your slide show.
