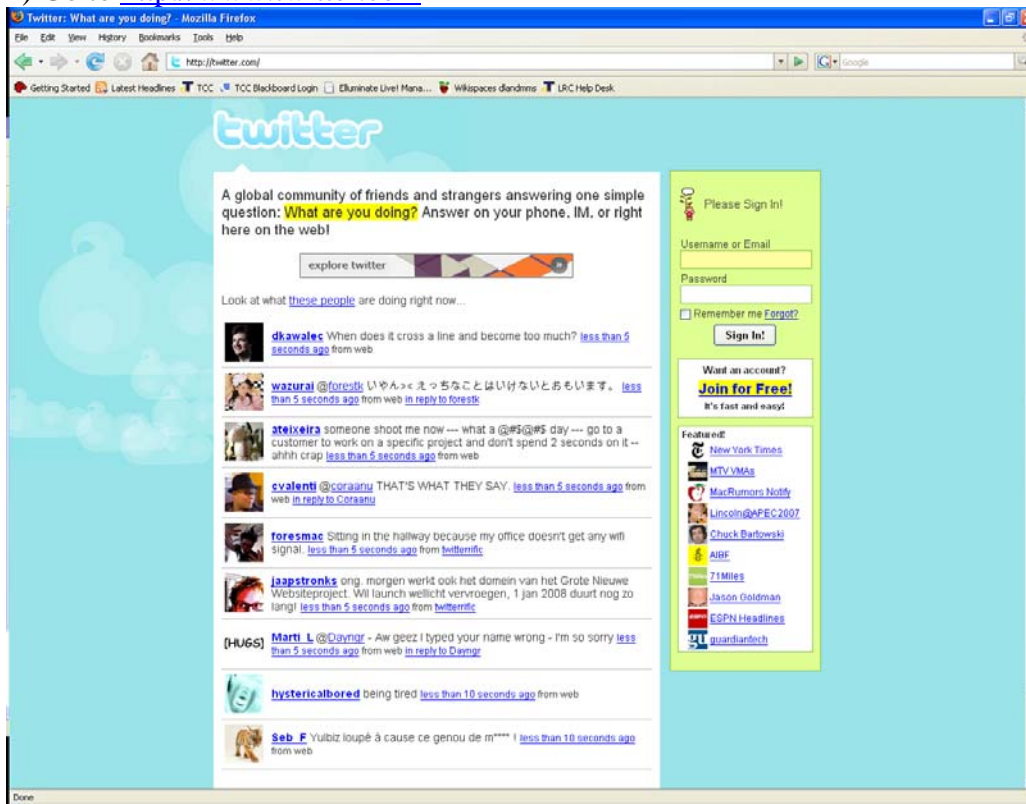


How to Setup Twitter Account to Have Texts Sent to Phone

1) Go to <http://www.twitter.com>

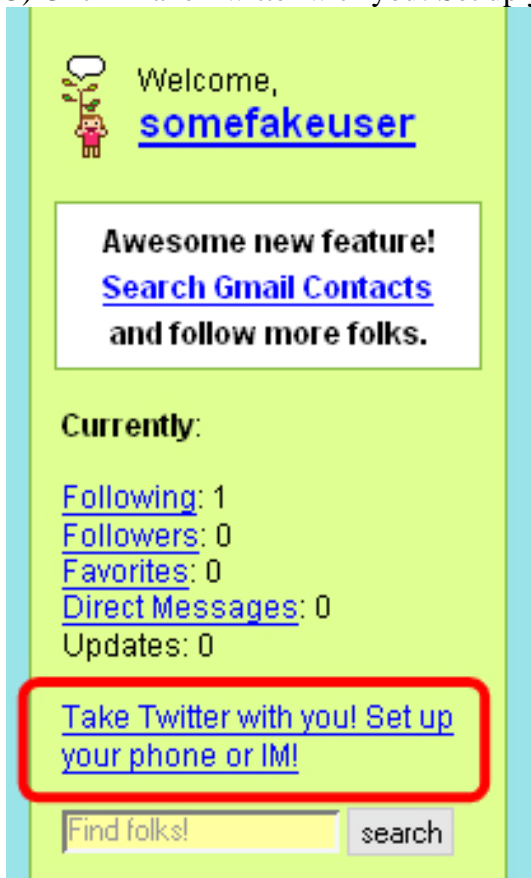


2) Log into Twitter Account (For more information on how to get a new Account refer to the “Create a Twitter Account Instructions”)

- Enter username or email
- Enter password
- Click “Sign In!”



3) Click “Take Twitter with you! Set up your phone or IM!”




4) Enter your mobile number in the text box. Enter the number with no spaces, dashes, parenthesis, or periods. Example: 2225558888

5) Select the check box “It’s okay for Twitter to send txt messages to my phone. Std. rates apply” and click “Save”


