Changes and Clarifications

#3 PORTAGE

No yoke permitted, but the thwart may be padded.
Failure to have the packframe on board at the finish results in disqualification.

#4 PACKBOARD RACE

The lashing rope may not be marked.
Two contestants may relash the load only if it falls apart in the transfer area.
Every team member is responsible for walking the course to learn it.
Disqualification results if the transfer is made outside of the designated area.
Disqualification results if the load is lashed illegally.

#6 AXE THROW

Change in scoring:
Bulls'-eye scoring:

Bulls'-eye	25 points
12"	15 points
24"	10 points

#8 DOT SPLIT

Each contestant has four bolts of wood. 25 points per dot.

Change in scoring:	
Within $\frac{1}{4}$ "	15 points
Within $\frac{3}{4}$ "	10 points
Over $\frac{3}{4}$ "	no points

No practice swings which strike the bolt may be taken.

#11 FELLING

Distance measurement is from the original hit, and not from where the pole may bounce.
Teams may not peel off bark.

#12 SCOOT LOAD

Logs must start within a box marked on the ground.

#13 SPLITTING

No orange or red crayons may be used to mark the bolts.
The quarters from each bolt may not be mixed together.
A quarter piece will count only if it contains a portion of the flat bottom face of the bold.
The second and third man may not go back to split any previous men's bolts.

#16 & 17 SAWING EVENTS

Lubricant may not be applied to the blade during the event.

#18 PULP THROW FOR ACCURACY

Time limit is 16 minutes. No points will be awarded after that time.

19 LOG ROLL

Log must touch stake with rounded length of log, not with flat end.
