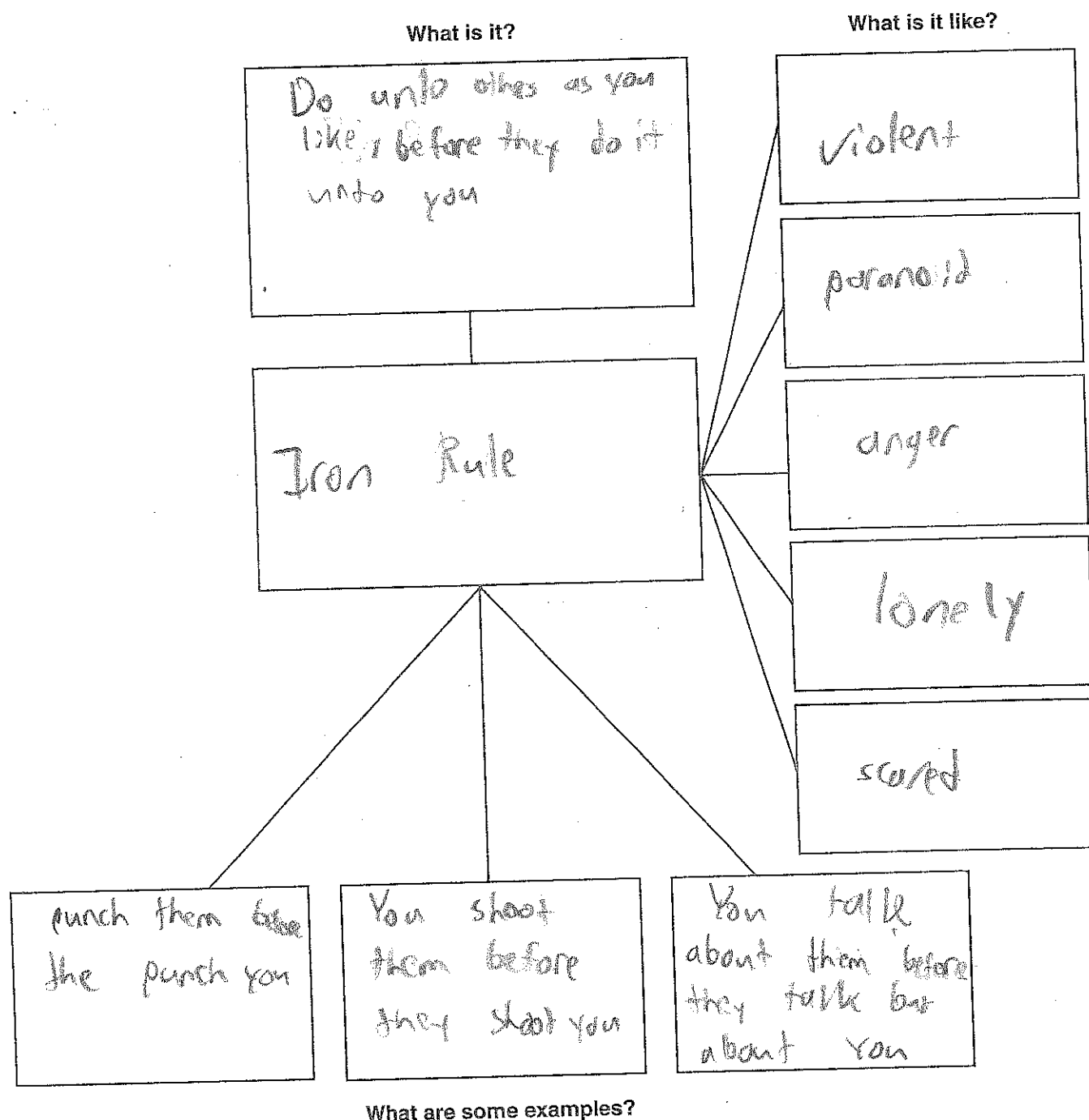


# Concept/Definition Map
