In addition to the options listed under the Universal Instruction the following learning strategies may be appropriate:

- Literature Circle Groups
- Book Club
- Math Club
- Academic competitions
- Short term flexible groups in specific subject areas
- Honors math courses (Beginning in seventh grade)
- Honors Language Arts or Dual Science (Beginning in ninth grade)
- AP Classes (Beginning in tenth grade)
- Cluster grouping
