



Copy, hide, or delete objects using the **Edit** menu.

Some objects have their own menus, which appear when the object is selected.

Need help? Choose **TinkerPlots Help** from the **Help** menu.

Hold the cursor over a button to see what it does.

Made a mistake? Choose **Undo** from the **Edit** menu as many times as you need to.

Printing? Choose **Show Page Breaks** from the **File** menu.

Drag object icons into your document to create objects.

Organize case icons in your plot.

Add features to your plot, such as the mean or a reference line. Some features will appear only in certain plots.

Click the attribute to color icons in your plot. Drag the attribute onto a plot axis to graph it.

Try not to overlap objects.

Mix up the plot.

Change icon type or size.

Change case values, add cases, or draw on the plot. Click the tool, then click in the plot.

Data Cards Use data cards to enter or edit data and change your plot.



Case Table Use a case table to see more than one case at a time. Cases appear as rows and attributes appear as columns. You can also enter new data and control your plot using a case table.



Text Use a text box to explain your data or answer questions from your assignment.



Picture Use a picture to illustrate your data. Copy the picture in its program, click in a blank part of the TinkerPlots document, then choose **Paste Picture** from the TinkerPlots **Edit** menu.



Plot Use a plot to graph your data.



Formula Editor You can use formulas to define attributes or filter out cases from the plot. Choose **TinkerPlots Help** from the **Help** menu to learn how.



Slider You can use a slider to change values for an attribute defined by a formula. Choose **TinkerPlots Help** from the **Help** menu to learn how.



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Annotations:

- Double-click to edit.
- Click to deselect all attributes.
- Click to attribute name to color icons in your plot. Drag onto a plot axis to graph. Double-click to edit.
- Double-click to edit color.
- Click to select the case in your plots. Click outside to deselect.
- Click to browse cases.
- Click to enter or edit.
- Click to add a new attribute.
- Drag to change column width.
- Double-click to enter or edit a formula.
- Click to lock plot color.
- Drag any icon to the right or up to make more bins. Drag to the left or down to make fewer bins.
- Drag to the left to make narrower bins. Drag to the right to make wider bins.
- Double-click first or last bin numbers to edit.
- Drag any row name to change order of bins.
