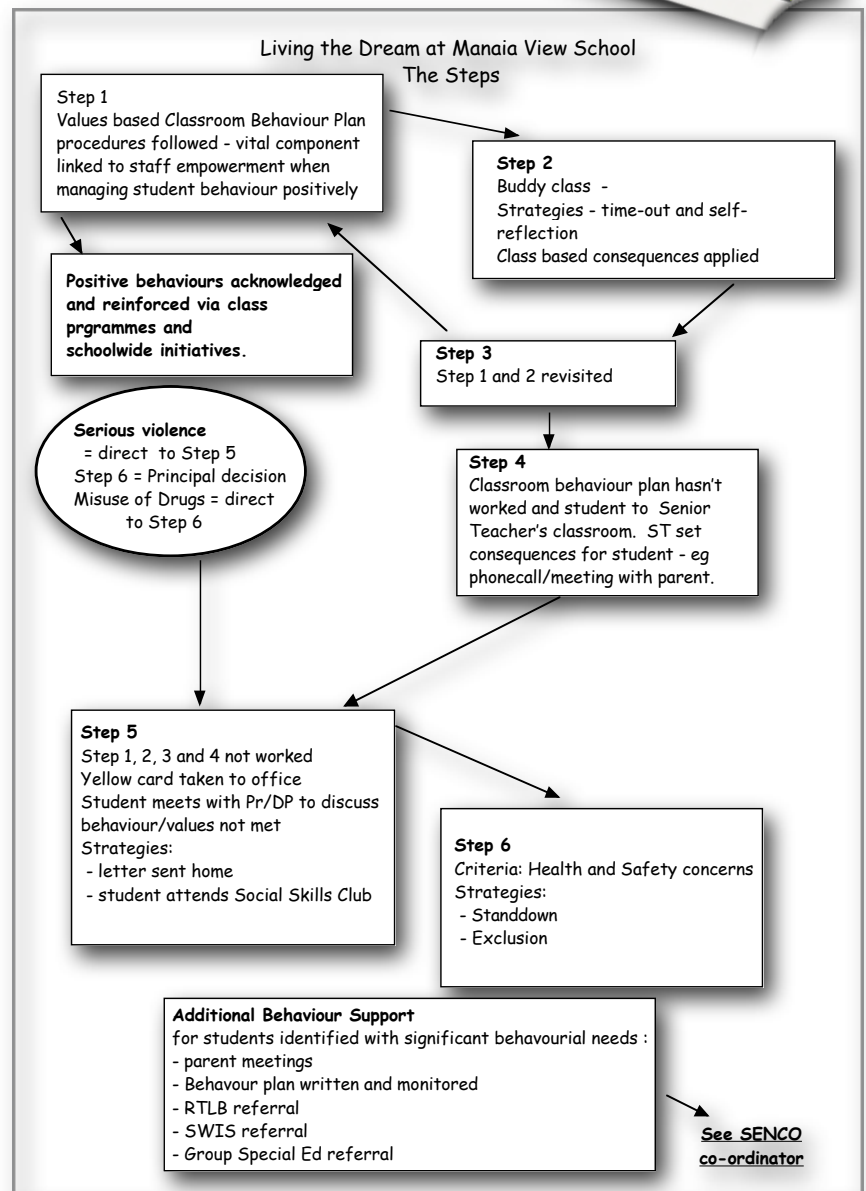
- # the individual

1. A "Living the Dream" display which includes:

  - \* Class statements for each value(uara)
  - \* School expectations/programme details displayed in a child friendly way.
  - \* The Class Behaviour Plan which includes the positive and negative consequences, negotiated and understood by students.
  - \* Social Skills Group information
  - \* Current focus value identified along with its meaning
