Putting Ideas into Action - Part Two

Participants will further explore relevant research from past projects completed in Putting Ideas into Action Part One. This includes, but is not limited to student achievement results, cross-curricular activities, as well further examination of educational research best practices. Participants will continue to explore or extend research on the three target areas of: Content Literacy Skills, Motivating the Reluctant Learner, Teaching the At-Risk Learner. By having completed a previous project based upon research of a problem and solution that affects student learning and teacher instruction, participants will be familiar with course expectations. Participants can either continue to research further implications of their previous study and/or develop adaptations of a successful project (i.e. additional literacy development, differentiation of instruction, intervention models or interdisciplinary units). Participants can expect to demonstrate research findings, group learning experiences, evidence of accomplishment (teacher and students) and reflection logs for full course credit. Scheduled dates are for large group meetings. Smaller group meetings and fieldwork are required in order to meet the course requirements. Prerequisite is CEGE 675-R01. NYS Learning Standard: ALL.
