

Industry means.....

The bodies that have a stake in the services provided by RTOs. These can include but are not limited to:

- a) Enterprise/industry clients, e.g. employers;
- b) Group training organisations;
- c) Industry organisations;
- d) Industry regulators;
- e) Industry skills councils or similar bodies;
- f) Industry training advisory bodies; and
- g) Unions.

Industry engagement may include but is not limited to, strategies such as:

- a) Partnering with local employers, regional/national businesses, relevant industry bodies and/or local enterprise RTOs;
- b) Involving employer nominees in industry advisory committees and/or reference groups;
- c) Embedding staff within enterprises;
- d) Networking in an ongoing way with industry networks, peak bodies and/or employers;
- e) Developing networks of relevant employers and industry representatives to participate in assessment validation; and
- f) Exchanging knowledge, staff, and/or resources with employers, networks and industry bodies
