


All About Our Outside E-Mail Filter

At TPS, we have multiple e-mail filtering systems. One of them is an outside system from a company called MX Logic.

MX Logic will send you an e-mail every time it receives something it thinks is Junk. It will continue to send you an report daily for about a week or so until you decide whether to release or deny that e-mail.

Make sure the Junk Mail filter in your email application doesn't flag those reports from MX Logic as junk mail.





Mail thinks this message is Junk Mail.

You can see in the report who the email is from and decide directly in the report whether to release, always allow, or deny that email. Each of these will then open a web browser window to finalize your choice.



You can also click to delete all messages or view your list of quarantined messages. Here in the browser I can also choose individual emails and decide what to do with them.

Besides quarantined e-mails, you also can allow or deny certain email senders through the filtering system. Click on the allow/deny button, and add to your lists.

Just close the web browser when you're finished.
