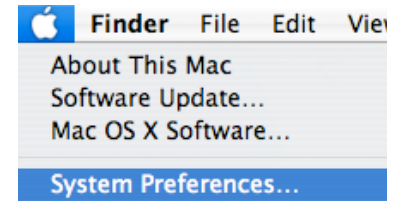


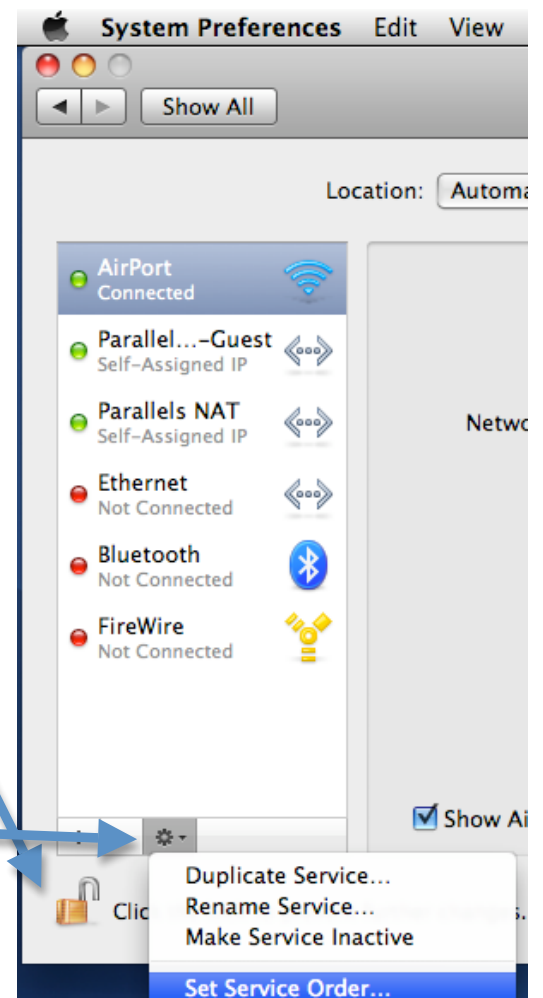
# Choosing Ethernet Before Airport

Being hard wired to the network/Internet is faster than using a wireless signal. If both signals are one, how to you make sure you are taking advantage of the fastest speed? It's called setting your service order.

1. Click on the Apple icon at the top left of your menu bar, choose "System Preferences" then click on the "Network" icon.

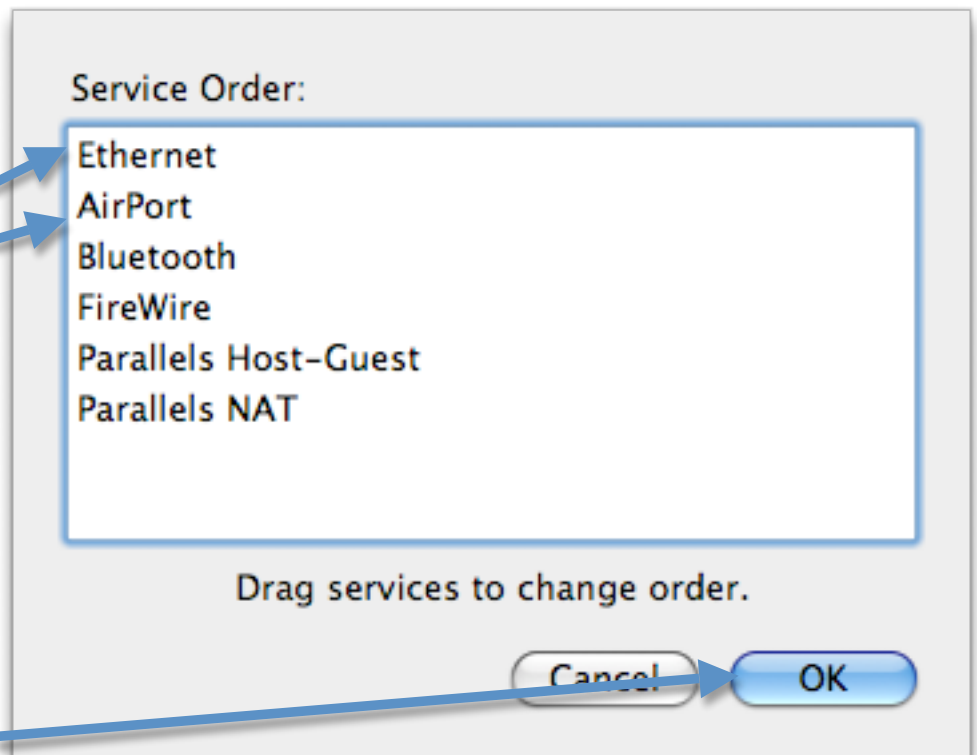


2. Unlock this system preference with the localadmin username and your password.



3. Click on the cog icon and choose Set Service Order.

4. Drag and drop Ethernet to the top of the list; have Airport second in the list.



5. Click the OK button.

6. Then click the Apply button.

You can then quit System Preferences.
