

**Assignment Five: Multimodal Composition (corollary to final project):**

DUE: In-Class Presentations, 4/14/08 through 4/21/08

This project begins with a story that you want to tell about your subject. For this first part, review a sample digital story at: <http://www.storycenter.org/stories/>

Your task is to construct a short “story” about your subject, using still and moving visual images and audio. Some of the audio must be your own written material, some can be music, and some can be material you’ve recorded but are the words of people in your study. We will work with iMovie (MovieMaker) and audacity for this part.

This project is a way for you to think in multi-dimensional terms about your work and how it can be presented on the Internet. The best way to go about this is to select images first. Second, determine what text and audio might accompany those images (quotations, narration, music). Last, craft your entire “story” in a logical order, making sure it is no longer than ten minutes.
