

CYBERSAFETY – ICON Readiness

Professional Learning Opportunity

In 2012 school staff will again be offered Professional Learning in Cybersafety in preparation for ICON Ultranet . In Semester 1, 3 workshops “Cybersafety – ICON Ultranet readiness” will be offered at 3 different venues. This is the same professional learning that has been offered for the past 3 years, facilitated by the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA). This program gives a positive, up to date and comprehensive overview of issues related to online activity. It is advisable to send relevant staff members to this professional learning if they have not attended ACMA training in the last 3 years.

In addition to this, ACMA has kindly developed further training for Catholic Schools in Curriculum and Policy development. In Semester 2, 3 workshops “Cybersafety – Developing Curriculum and Policy” will be offered at 3 different venues. This day will look at how Cybersafety can be embedded in the school, how it can be taught and what our policies might include. Schools staff should have attended the ICON Ultranet readiness PL (in the last few years) before attending this Professional Learning (PL) activity. Participants will be asked to bring their existing Cybersafety / ICT policies to this PL.

The program has been funded through the Australian Government Quality Teacher Program (AGQTP). **Schools wishing to participate in the program will need to enrol via the Integrated Professional Learning System (IPLS).**

Target Group: ICON School Leaders and staff with responsibility for student wellbeing.
