



## School Support Model for the Implementation of ICON

### ICON READINESS 2011

#### ICON COACHES

ICON coaches will provide support to schools with the aim of maximising the use of ICON to support contemporary learning and teaching.

Each ICON coach will support primary and secondary regional networks as appropriate for the diocese.

ICON coaches will be responsible for:

- Working collaboratively with ICON School Leaders to ensure ICON readiness
- Contributing to school and region based ICON professional learning
- Modelling the effective use of ICT to support contemporary learning and teaching

#### Role of ICON coaches

In **semester 1 and 2, 2011**, the main role of the ICON coaches will be to ensure schools are ready for ICON by supporting schools to:

- Understand the benefits of ICON
- Make links with school implementation planning
- Review infrastructure
- Ensure data is ready for ICON
- Maximise the use of the ePotential ICT capabilities survey
- Review and update policies
- Use ICON to support contemporary learning and teaching

Once schools are connected to ICON, the role of the ICON coach will be to:

- Support schools to familiarise themselves with ICON modules
- Provide ongoing support for ICON school leaders to implement ICON in their school

## ICON SCHOOL LEADERS

### Selection of ICON School Leaders

Each school will be asked to nominate ICON School Leader/s, one of whom is a member of the school leadership team.

When selecting ICON school leaders, consideration should be given to personnel who are:

- positive role models
- good communicators
- willing to use ICT to support contemporary learning and teaching.

The suggested number of ICON School leaders per school is based on enrolment.

School size	ICON School Leaders
<50	1
51-100 students	1-2
101 – 400 students	2-3
401 – 800 students	2-5
> 800 students	3-6



## **Role of ICON school leaders**

**ICON School Leaders will be responsible for leading the implementation of ICON in their school.**

### **ICON Readiness for 2011 involves:**

- Making provision for management structures and processes which will support the school in being ICON Ready.
- Developing and/or reviewing eLearning plans in the context of School Improvement
- Developing and/or reviewing Cybersafety, Acceptable Use and Copyright policies, having procedures to enact these and developing Cybersafety curriculum
- Monitoring leaders and teacher ICT capabilities (ePotential) and developing and strengthening the use and integration of ICT to support powerful learning and teaching
- Auditing the school's infrastructure and taking appropriate action with regard to readiness for ICON

As ICON develops, the ICON School Leaders will be responsible for:

- Leading the implementation of ICON in their school and professional learning of their staff
- Leading the development of school processes to support students and parents in the use of ICON.

*ICON School Leaders will have the support of ICON Coaches at regional workshops, through online learning opportunities and through school visits.*
