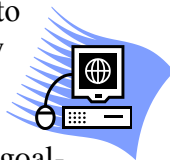
A Special Article from the Library

**Destiny** is the online catalog of books available for check out in our library.

**Renaissance Place** is the web-based version of the STAR Reading and Accelerated Reader programs we've used in the past. These programs enable your child's classroom teacher to more efficiently monitor quality reading based on reading ranges and encourage increased quantity and quality of reading using individual goal-setting. Sign up for email alerts under the Home Connect link.

You and your child can access these programs by visiting Eastview's website: ➔click on Library Links. This will open to our library homepage with links to helpful websites. Click on the "Catalog" tab to search our library materials.



Read with your child as often as possible. Make connections to your family life, and ask open-ended questions about what they are reading such as:

- Who is your favorite character in the book?
- Where does the story take place (i.e. setting)? and/or
- What is one fact you remember from reading this book?
