Bring your quarters on Friday, November 2nd, for popcorn. Proceeds will help purchase books for our library.

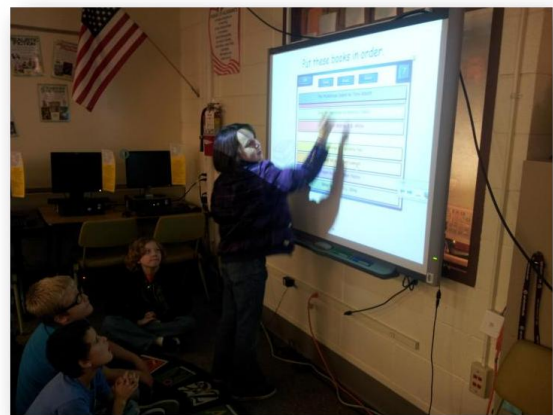
