To find out, check through the library's homepage: Renaissance Place.

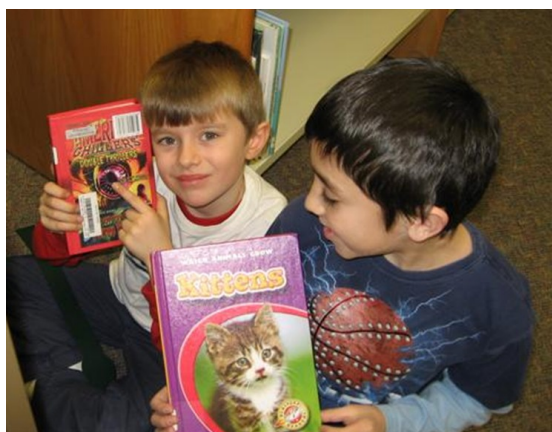
