- * Use a bookmark!
- * Return books when they are due.
- * Report rips or stains to Ms. F.
- * Keep books stored in backpack when not being read.



Picking out a "Just Right" book: **Use the Five Finger Rule**

1. Choose a book you think you'll enjoy.
2. Read the second page.
3. Hold up one finger for each word you do not know or are unsure of.
4. If there are five or more fingers up from words you didn't know, select a another book.
