Provide timeline of events (no more than 6)

Include at least 3 pictures with captions

Right Panel-*Cold War Conflict (How does this fit into the larger*

Capitalism vs Communism struggle of the Cold War?)

Write a short “blurb” (8 sentences, 20pt font)

Include at least 2 pictures with captions

Bibliography-Hand in separately (DO NOT put on Triptych)

You need at least 5 information sources

(1 sentence annotation on the usefulness of the source)

You must cite all images you use in the bibliography (not on the triptych!)

You MAY use EasyBib for your bibliography

You MAY NOT use wikipedia as a source in the bibliography
