Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to my class! I am so excited to partner with you this year in making sure that your child receives the best education possible. First grade is such an important year in your child's development and I am honored to be able to guide him/her through it. I look forward to meeting and getting to know you at our open house, reading night, and parent night this fall!


I wanted to share with you some of our classroom rules so that you know what can be expected of me and what I expect from your students. Our classroom rules are as follows:

- Respect the classroom, your classmates, and the teacher.
- Come to class prepared.
- Be quiet and active listeners when someone is speaking.
- Have a positive attitude.
- Have fun!

I incorporate the use of a stoplight system in my classroom. Each student has a clothespin and starts the day out on green. If a rule is broken, the student moves to the top of green, then yellow, then red. If a student does not have to move his/her clothespin for an entire week, he/she is allowed to draw a prize out of the treasure box. At the end of the day, I hand out a small treat to the students who have behaved well for the entire day. Each time a student moves up on the stoplight, he/she owes me 5 minutes of recess time. If a student reaches red by the end of the day, he/she is sent to the principal's officer for further discipline. If there is ever a serious discipline issue such as fighting, bringing prohibited items to school, etc., the student will immediately be referred to the principal's office.

I base my classroom on respect. I like to start each day with a clean slate, believing that we all deserve the chance to have a better day. I am looking forward to getting to know each of your students and will work very hard to ensure that they learn to their fullest potential. I work hard and expect the same of my students. We will surely have a really fun and exciting year with lots and lots of learning!
