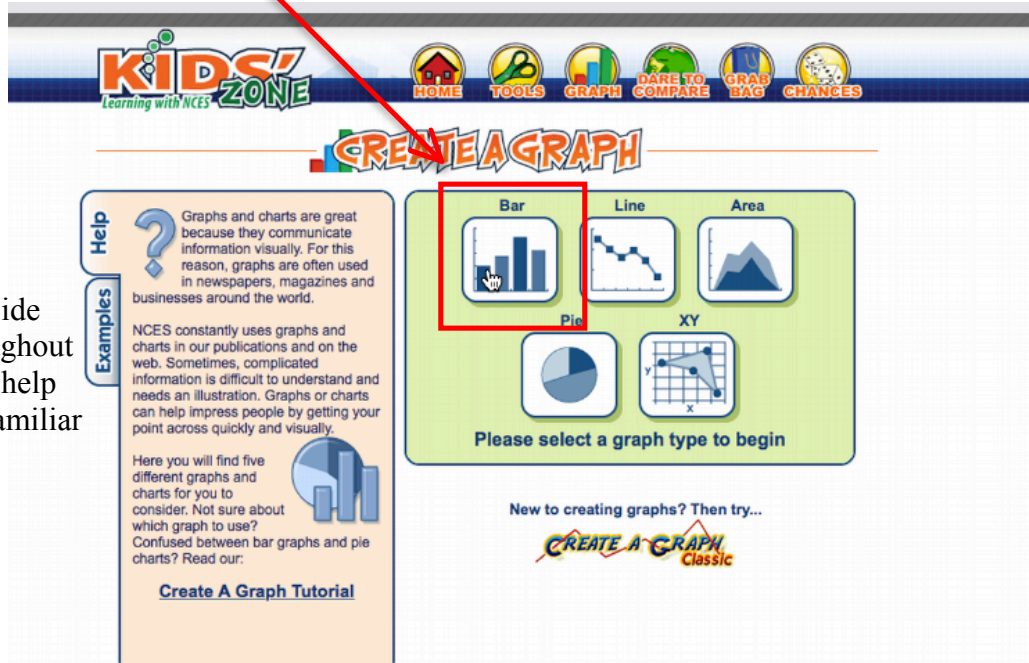
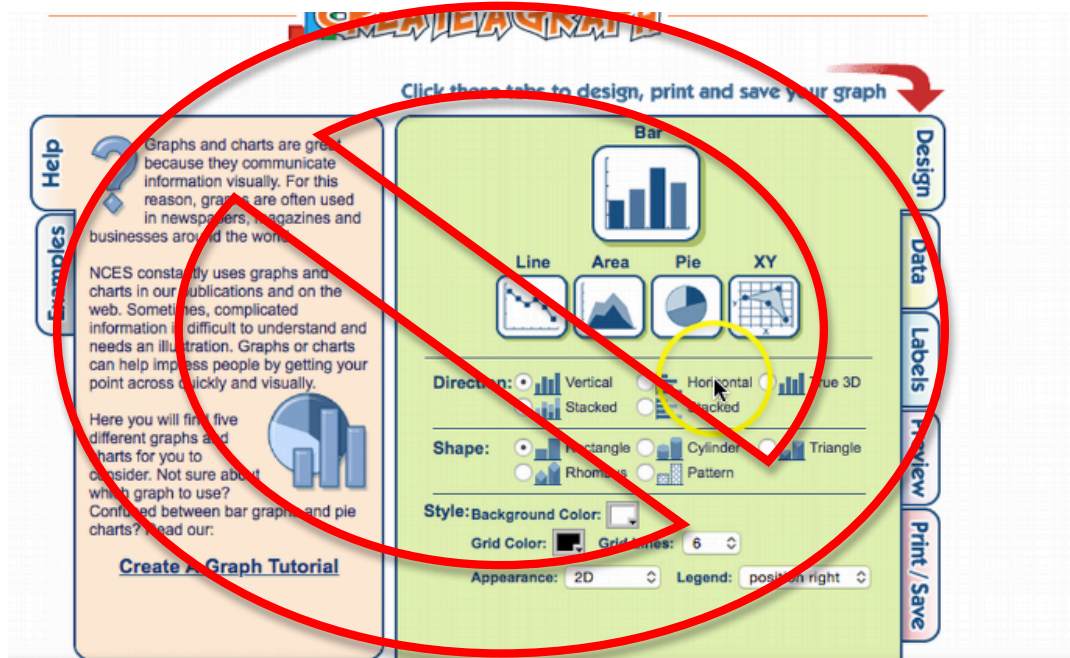


Using KidsZone- Create a Graph

1. Click on “Bar” on this page



2. Keep all of the setting on this tab as is! Move on to the next tab labeled- “Data”



3. Fill in the data you want on your chart. See the completed example in the next step.

5. You can change the font or label color on this but don't touch anything else!

Help Choosing the right look and feel is important when designing a graph.

Examples

Show Labels: displays the values on the graph

Type: is the data-specific value shown with each label

Prefix: is added to the beginning of a data label, such as (\$)

Suffix: is added to the end of a data label, such as (lbs, kg, cm, ft, ♦, %)

Position: where the data labels are displayed on the graph

Label Color: the color of the data labels

Background Color: the color behind the data labels. By default the background is transparent.

Font: sets the font style for all text and values in the graph

Font Color: the color of all text and values

Font size: the font size of all text and values

6. Click on the next tab "Preview" to show the graph you just made. If you are unhappy with something go back and fix it by going through the tabs again.

Help **Graph Preview:** shows you the current state of your graph. To make changes, click the *Design*, *Labels*, and *Data* tabs. To print or download this graph, click the *Print/Save* tab.
