

## Using Safari, Comic Book! and Edmodo apps together for a iPad project.

### Instructions for teachers:

- 1) Check to make sure you are on HCS-WPA (network)
- 2) Open Safari
- 3) Login if needed
- 4) Go to <http://pics.tech4learning.com> to find images
- 5) Save at least four images of animals to your photo gallery
- 6) Close Safari



- 1) Open Comic Book!
- 2) Tap Create – New – OK
- 3) Tap Create and select your frame layout
- 4) Add images of animals to each frame and add effects
- 5) Add captions for each animal
- 6) Add a title
- 7) Tap Create and Save Image
- 8) Close Comic Book!



- 1) Open Edmodo (app) and login
- 2) Tap the camera at the top of the screen
- 3) Select Albums and find your comic in the Camera Roll
- 4) Tap your comic, move and scale it
- 5) Tap Use
- 6) Tap away from the box to close it
- 7) Tap the Library icon (books) to see your comic
- 8) Tap the comic and the magnifying glass to view it



### Instructions for students:

Students can use the same procedures as teachers, but their Edmodo library is called a backpack.

If the Edmodo camera doesn't work:

- 1) Tap Add To Backpack – Files – Upload
- 2) Tap Choose Existing and find the comic in the Camera Roll
- 3) Tap Add
- 4) Make sure the file is in the backpack

Upon completion of the assignment, students should:

- 1) Add their comic/file/image to their backpack in Edmodo
- 2) Log out of Edmodo
- 3) Delete the comic/file/image from the Camera Roll

This type of procedure will be necessary since several students will share one iPad.
