Speaks Clearly - 10%	Speaks clearly and distinctly all (100-95%) the time, and mispronounces no words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly most (100-95%) of the time, and rarely mispronounces words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly enough (94-85%) of the time. Mispronounces a few words.	Often mumbles or can not be understood OR commonly mispronounces words.
Listens & Engages - 20%	Listens intently. Does not make distracting noises or movements. Presents thoughtful questions and insights.	Listens intently but has one distracting noise or movement. Asks average questions, adds to discussion.	Sometimes does not appear to be listening but is not distracting. Speaks in conversation, does not ask questions.	Sometimes does not appear to be listening and has distracting noises or movements. Little to no engagement in questioning or discussion.
