Session 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain to students that they are going to create a broadcast for Joan and her friends in Kenya to teach them about what they have been learning. Their broadcast must address geography, economics and civics as well as how they have become a responsible global citizen throughout this unit. Each group will also be in charge of asking and answering guiding questions along the way.• Review with students what they have learned throughout the unit. Create a list of possible ideas that students can present for their broadcast.• Show students the Ustream video.
Session 2	<p>Days 2-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Break students into groups and fill out the Ustream guideline sheet.• Begin working on broadcast.• Use the Final Project Sheet to help guide you through your research. <p>Days 3-4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Record your video broadcast and share it with your classmates. Post your videos on the EFAC blog to share with Joan and her friends.
