

**Grade Level:** Fourth

**Content Area:** Introduction to Unit

**Objective:** Students will learn connect about the geography, culture, wildlife, and more about Kenya to connect with their own state research in the upcoming lessons.

**Vocabulary:** Teachers- please note that students should work collaboratively to develop definitions for each vocabulary word based on research and background knowledge.

Webquest, traditions, conversions

**Procedure:**

Advance Preparation	Browse through webquest and print and copy any worksheets you will collect from your students. You may elect to have every child complete every worksheet independently, work in groups, or give each group one activity from the webquest to share with the class.
Session 1  This could take anywhere from one day to ten days depending on the requirements of the teacher.	Visit the Webquest, "Kenya" and explain to students that webquests are a way to travel and experience a topic on the Internet by completing given research tasks. On this webquest students will explore five different activities:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Discovering geographical facts</li><li>2. The people and the culture</li><li>3. The animals and wildlife</li><li>4. Tourist tips</li><li>5. Creating a PowerPoint (we recommend skipping this portion and having students tie in their learning from this webquest by comparing Kenya to their state in their final project)</li></ol>

**Differentiation Strategies:**
