

Grade Level: Third

Content Area: Final Project

Objective: Students will demonstrate their understanding of becoming a responsible global citizen by developing a project proposal to raise money for the students in Kenya.

Vocabulary: *Teachers- please note that students should work collaboratively to develop definitions for each vocabulary word based on research and background knowledge.*

Responsible global citizen, proposal, execute plan, impact

Procedure:

Session 1	Explain to students that it's our turn to give back to this important cause. But how? This is up to them. If desired show the list of fundraising ideas or generate a list of your own about ways communities work together to help an important cause. Show the Houses for Haiti PowerPoint. Tell the students that this is one example of how a school community proposed a project idea and implemented it to raise money for Haiti.
Session 2	Divide students into groups of 4 or 5. In groups, allow students to brainstorm an idea. How will they raise \$750? Use the note-catcher as a guide from the project proposal guidelines to help students draft their proposal. Teachers may need to assist by asking students guiding questions to ensure proposals are realistic.
Sessions 3-6	Allow groups to work on a way to present their idea (PowerPoint, poster, glog, anything).
Session 7	Give students a chance to present in front of a panel of judges. We recommend a few teachers and parents. This will give the students an authentic audience and the panel can help select a project that is attainable. Use the judging criteria on the project proposal guidelines as an assessment rubric.
