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Session 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pose questions to students such as what would your life be like without an education? How does education make the world a better place? What would you do if you had to pay for your education? Would you be able to afford it? Explain that in many parts of the world education is not free.• Education For All Children is a Non-Profit that was formed to help provide scholarship aide to the brightest but most impoverished kids in Kenya.• This organization gave us a scholarship student named Joan.• Give students time to explore the EFAC webpage.• Pass out the Question Guide to students. In partners or individually students go through the webpage to learn more about Joan and EFAC.• Share Joan’s letter with the class and review what you have learned about Joan and EFAC.
Session 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Talk to students about blogging. Navigate students back to the EFAC blog. Give them time to look through the various blog posts.• Students choose one blog to become an expert on and share.• Divide students into groups to share their blog post.• Discuss the importance of an organization like EFAC and how it can help change the world.
