

## High-Frequency Word Administration

The first administration of the high-frequency word evaluation will occur in November; the second administration will occur in April; and the third administration will occur during summer school in the month of June. Please check the HISD testing calendar for exact dates.

The classroom teacher will administer the evaluation individually to all students in the classroom. Each word will be isolated from the rest of the list and the students will have 10 seconds to read each word. If the student stutters allow more time, or self corrects consider the response correct. Each correct response is 1 point.

The high-frequency word evaluation results are to be used as part of the promotion standards for grades 1 and 2.

### November Administration

- In grade 1, there will be 75 words on the evaluation. The student must respond correctly to at least 60 (80%) to be successful.
- In grade 2, there will be 100 words on the evaluation. The student must respond correctly to at least 80 (80%) to be successful.

### April Administration

- In grade 1, there will be 35 words on the evaluation. The student must respond correctly to at least 28 (80%) to be successful.
- In grade 2, there will be 60 words on the evaluation. The student must respond correctly to at least 48 (80%) to be successful.

### June Administration

- In grade 1, there will be 35 words on the evaluation. The student must respond correctly to at least 28 (80%) to be successful.
- In grade 2, there will be 60 words on the evaluation. The student must respond correctly to at least 48 (80%) to be successful.
