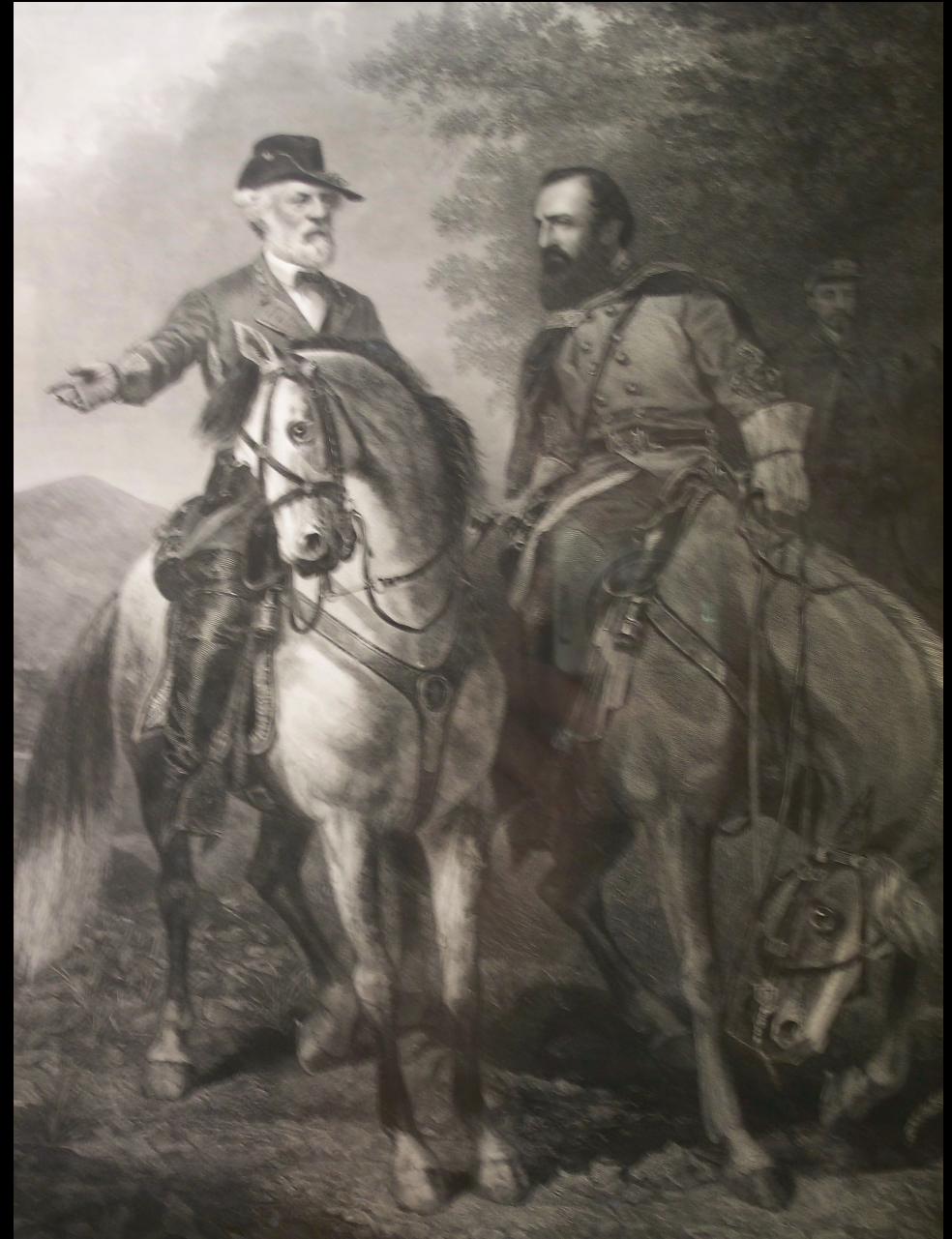

- *On May 2nd Jackson and his staff were returning to their campsite.
- *A group of soldiers requested to know who was coming before them. Before they received an answer they opened fire.
- *Jackson was shot three times. (Twice in his left arm and once in the right hand)
- *Some of his staff members were killed.



- *Jackson was evacuated the following day.
- *Dr. Hunter McGuire had to amputate Jackson's left arm.
- *Jackson was moved to Thomas C. Chandler's house called "Fairfield."
- *Jackson stayed in Chandler's plantation office building.
- *Jackson came down with pneumonia and died on May 10, 1863.

*Jackson's left arm was taken by his chaplain and buried at the J. Horace Lacy House called "Ellewood" near the field hospital.
