- *He is reported to have been killed soon after making this statement.

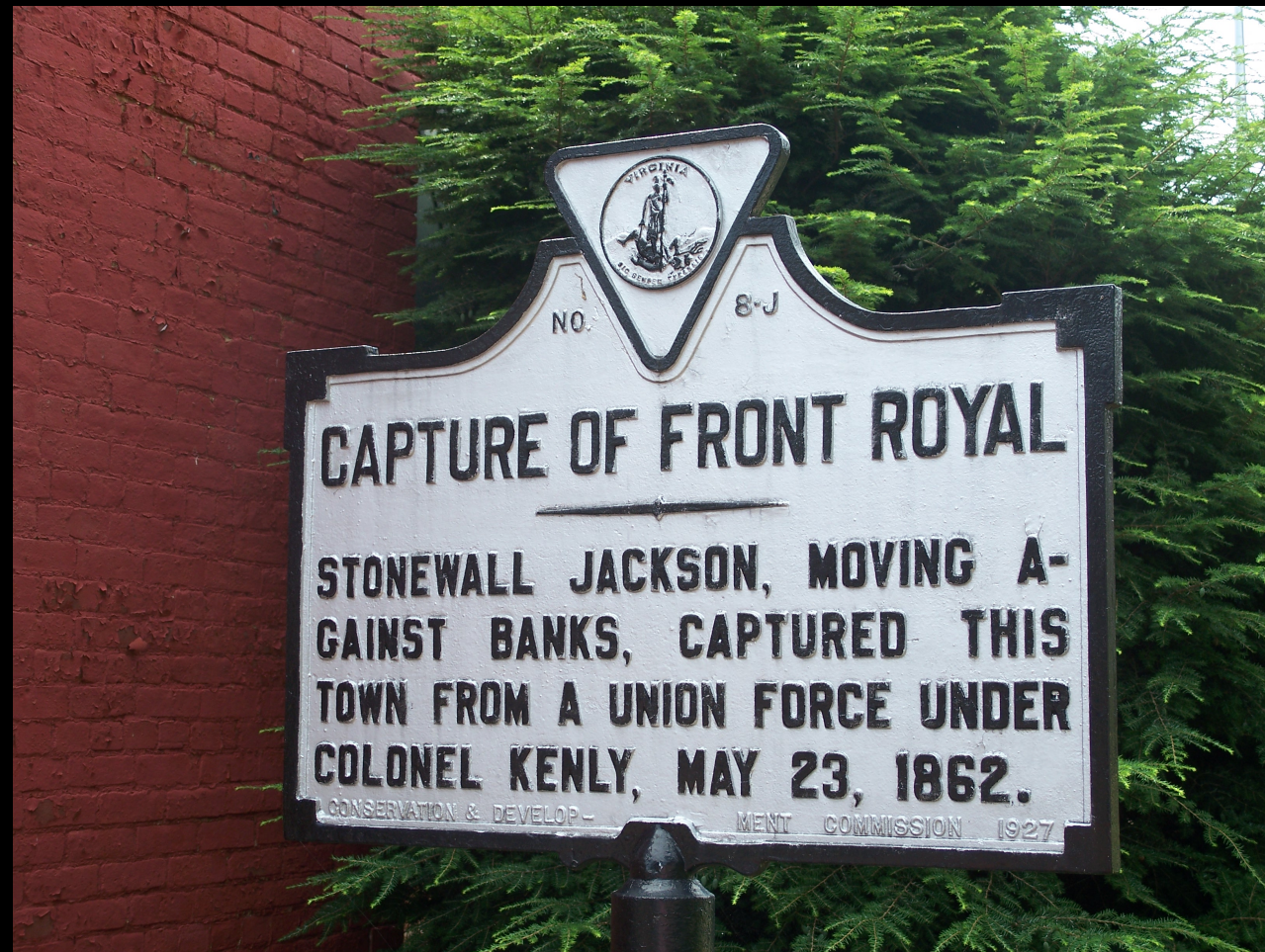
Battle of Manassas:

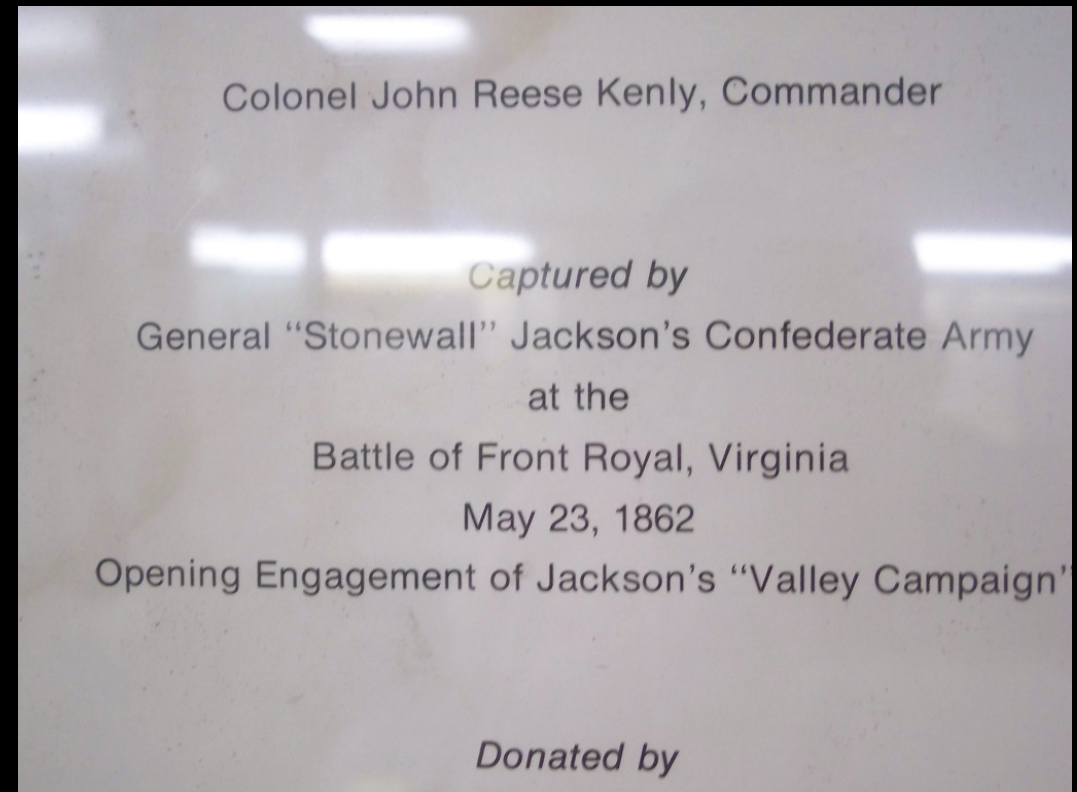




Jackson's Headquarters in Winchester Virginia
