# NEWS RELEASE FOR PLAQUING CEREMONIES.

## GENERAL.

Some sixteen years ago, the Institution of Engineers, Australia, initiated an Australian Engineering Plaquing Programme as a means of bringing public recognition to significant historic engineering works and to the engineers who created them. Such significant engineering works are those which have been judged to be valuable to a group of people through a retrospective survey. These works are marked with a bronze plaque by the agreement of the interested parties, particularly the owner.

For historic works or objects of particularly outstanding engineering importance, the Institution reserves its ultimate accolade, the National Engineering Landmark award. The item must have contributed significantly to the development of Australia and to the practice of engineering, and thus must represent a milestone by which progress is measured, or a benchmark by which comparisons are made. these works will be seen not only as part of Australia's engineering heritage, but also as significant components of the national Estate. they do more than mark an historic point or period of time.

For historic items which are of lesser significance at the national level, or are significant only within a particular State, region or community, the Historic Engineering Landmark award may be more appropriate. Such works may mark a significant point or period in history

To date, in Western Australia, the Coolgardie Goldfields Water Supply Scheme, the Fremantle Harbour and the Narrows Bridge have been recognised as National Engineering Landmarks, and the Albany Forts, the Perth Wireless Station (Applecross), Canning Dam, and the Rottnest Light Station have been recognised as Historic Engineering Markers.



## B. KALGOORLIE-BOULDER MINING.

This project has also been recognised for a National Engineering Landmark award.

In the 1900's, the annual gold production in Kalgoorlie-Boulder was the second highest of any mining centre in the world.

For the first time in the world, the mining engineers and metallurgists employed on the "Golden Mile" developed a new "all slime" process for treating refractory sulpho-teluride ore; and new equipment, such as the "tube mill" for fine ore crushing and the "filter press" equipment for cyanideing pulp.

Treatment costs were halved in four years and by 1905, Kalgoorlie-Boulder was recognised as the world leader in innovative gold metallurgy.

The 6,000 miners and their families played a crucial role, not only in developing a viable industry that has lasted over 100 years but also in bringing Western Australia into the 1901 Federation.

The development of the "all slime" process for the treatment of refractory sulpho-teluride gold ore for the first time in the world.

The development of the "tube mill" for fine ore crushing of gold ore for the first time in the world.

The development of the "filter press" equipment for cyaniding pulp for the first time in the world.

These and other technical developments were regarded as the world leaders in the area of gold production at that time.

The organised method of development of the various mines in this area ensured that they would be able to continue a viable mining operation which has lasted for over one hundred years.

It is a Gold Mining Complex that has been mined continuously for over one hundred years and has been in the forefront of innovative gold metallurgy.

It was the world's leading gold producer in the 1900-1905 period.

It has demonstrated the successful development of technology from one area of use into another area.

It provided the world's first "all slime" process for treating refractory sulpho-teluride gold ore.

It provided the world's first "tube mill" for fine ore crushing.

It provided the world's first "filter press" for cyanideing pulp.

The development of the mining sites were instrumental in playing a major part in the 1901 Federation of Australia.

It provided the necessary financial balance for trading and development between Britain, India and Australia in the 1890-1920 period .

It changed the Political pattern of Government.

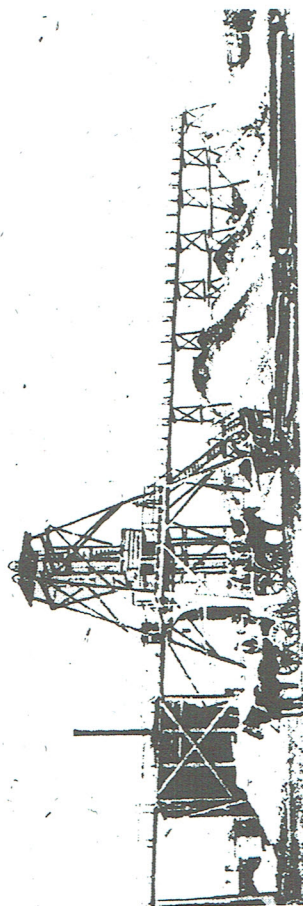
