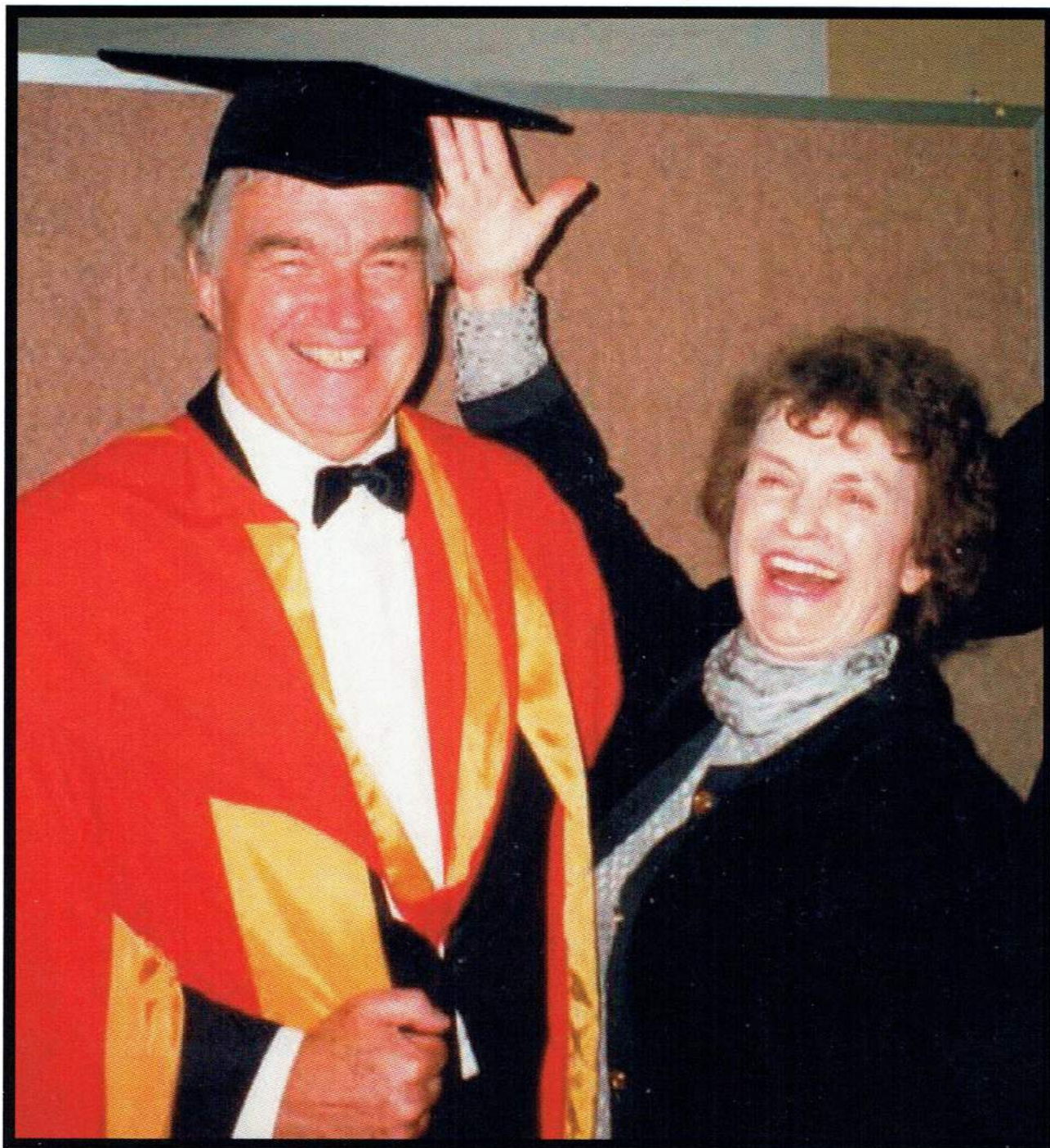

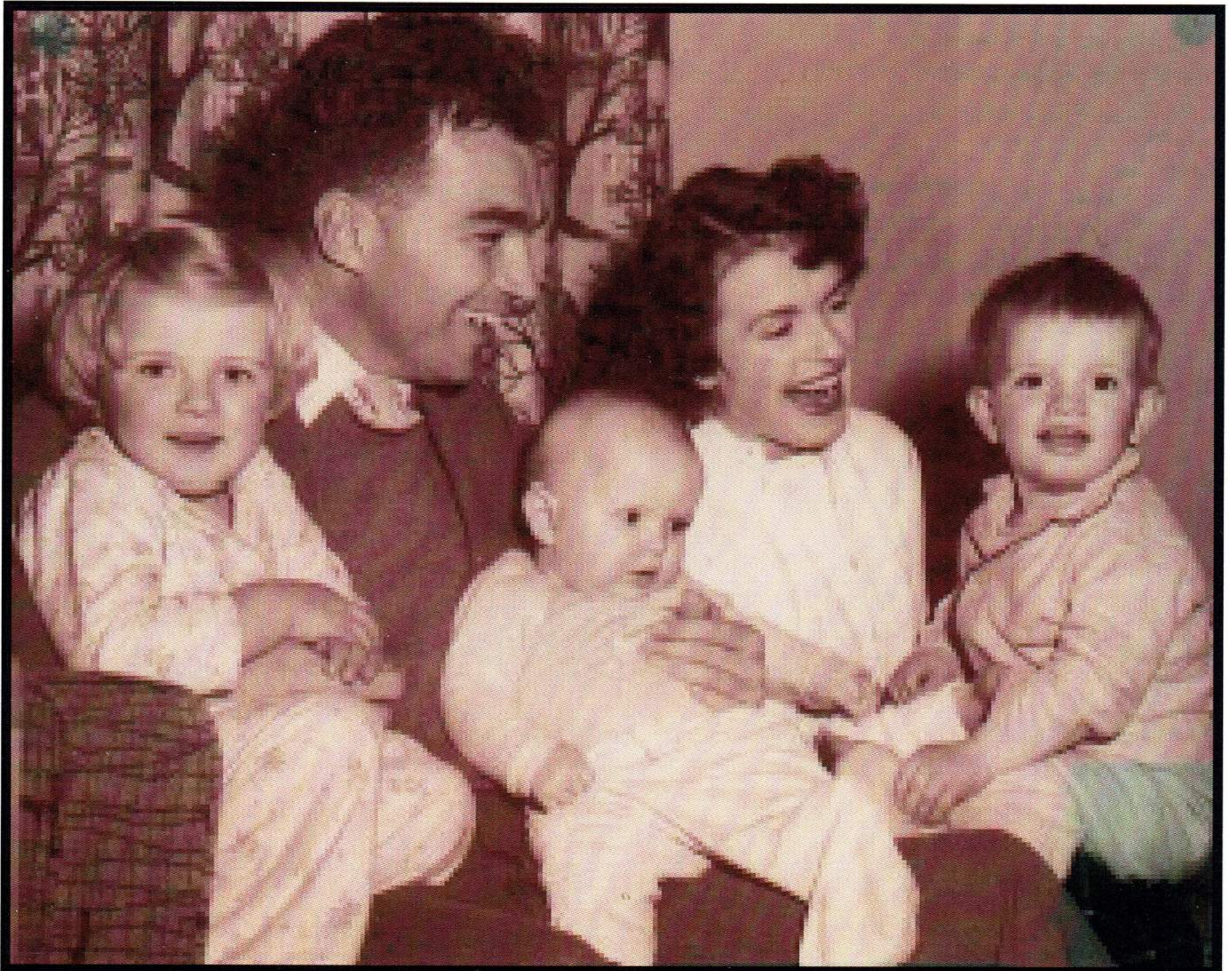

Loud your anthems raise.

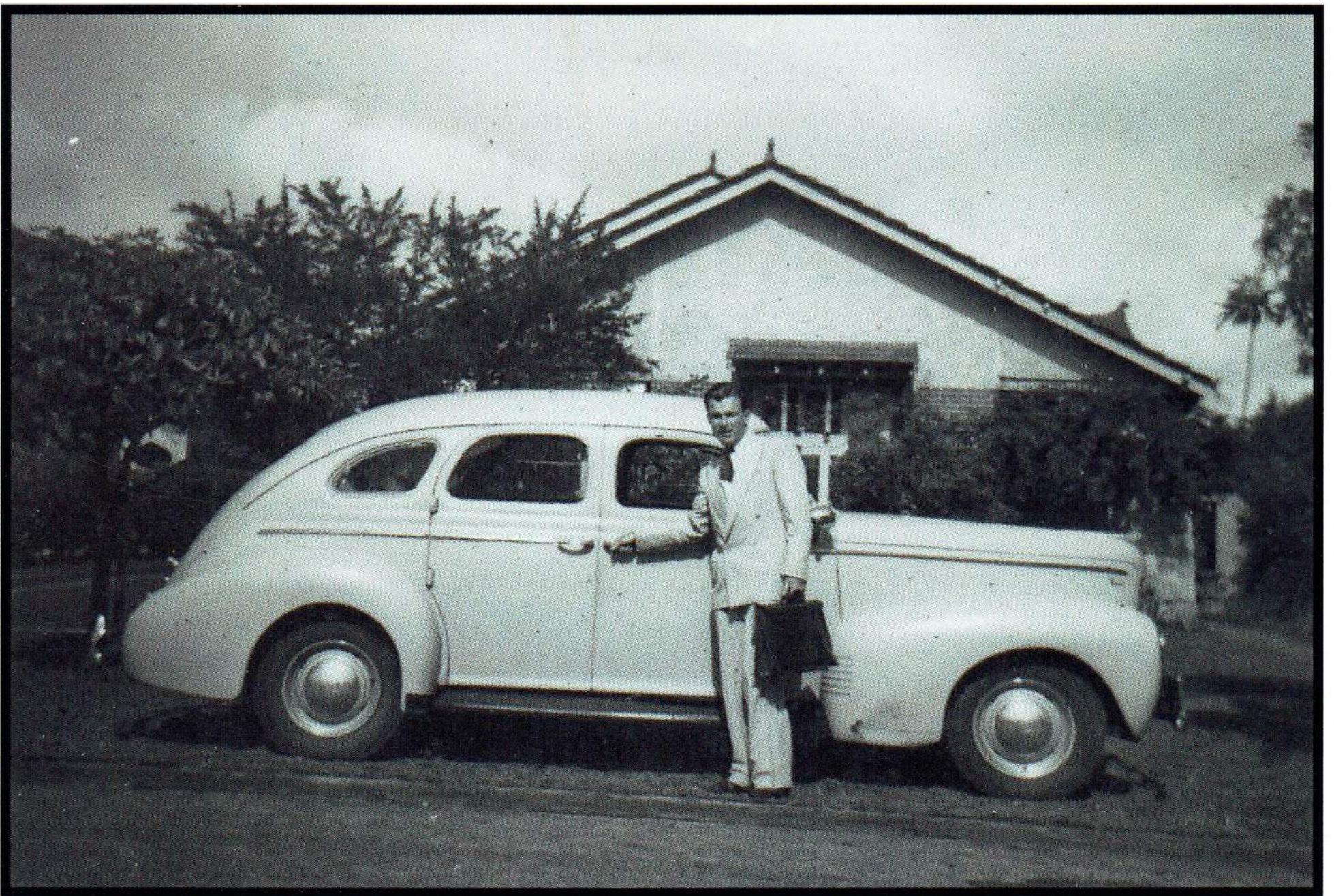
Like a mighty army
