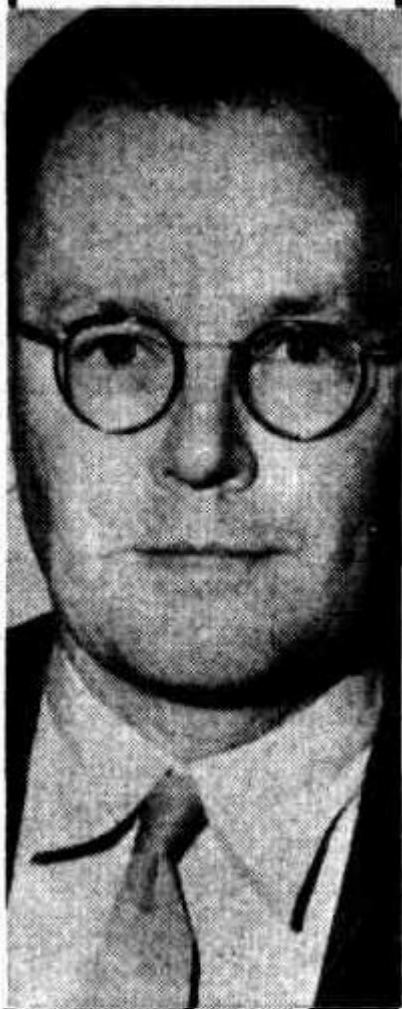


PROFESSOR ARRIVES
