Atkins & Partners, London, 1957, on secondment, working on nuclear power plants; Macdonald Wagner & Priddle, 1958-1970, surveyed and laid out Sydney Opera House, surveyed laid out and worked on three radio telescopes, one stellar interferometer, and two optical telescopes. Continued to work on bulk terminals for sugar, wheat, oil and gas in Australia and overseas; Managing Director of Macdonald Wagner, 1970-1984; Consultant Engineer, 1986- ; Director, Snowy Mountains Engineering Corp.; part time Director, Douglas Partners, Consulting Engineers; Fellow, Institution of Engineers, Australia.
