Paul helped drive the University of Queensland through a period of rapid growth and increased international standing.

With a strong reputation in education and administration in the chemical engineering faculty, he attracted support from business and all levels of government to develop several Centers of research.

Promoted through Executive Dean, Pro Vice Chancellor and Deputy Vice Chancellor, he was appointed Vice Chancellor in 2008. His development of seven Institutes as centers of excellence has seen some remarkable world firsts which continue to attract the brightest academics and students to the university.

He has extensive experience as a Board Director and is currently a Director on a number of company boards.

He has held the role of chair in the following organizations: Scientific Advisory Group of the South East Queensland Healthy Waterways partnership, the Expert Panel on Purified Recycled Water, the River symposium Strategic Planning Committee, and the International Water Centre.

In January 2006 Paul was made an Officer in the General Division of the Order of Australia for service to science and engineering, particularly through research in areas of chemical engineering, biotechnology, wastewater and environmental management, and to the tertiary education sector.
