

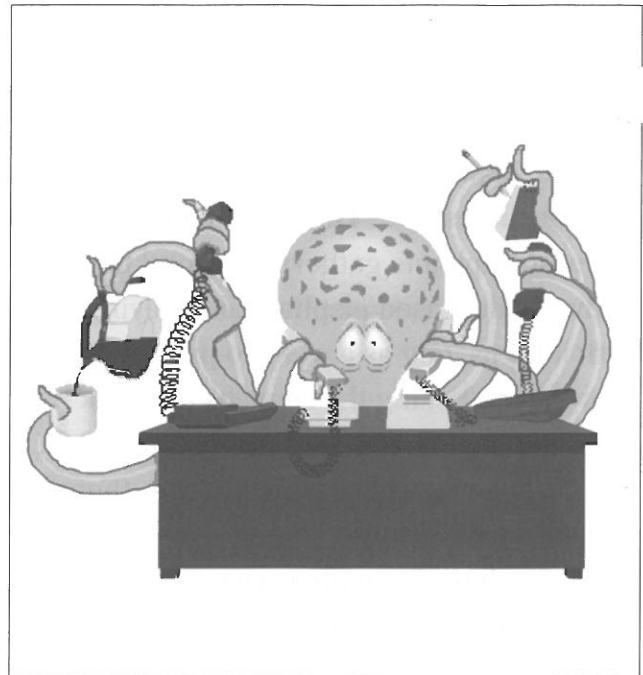
2. Up in Arms
