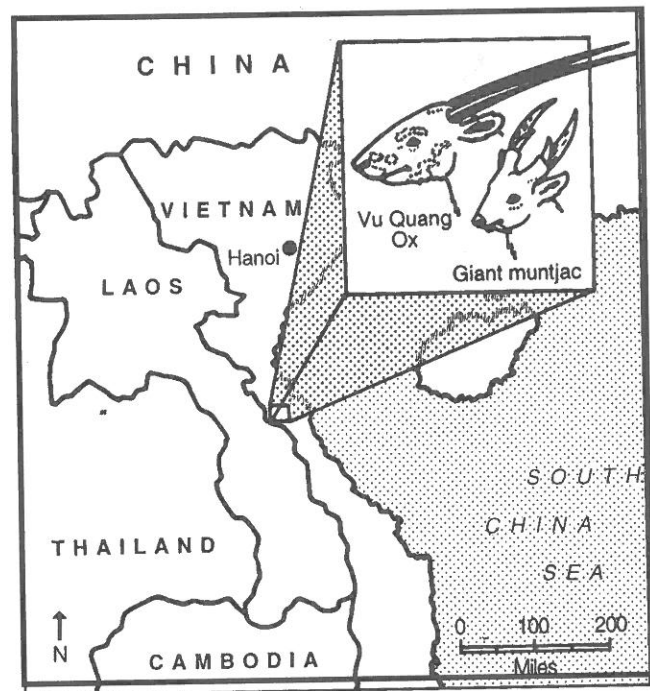


5. Mammal Discovery

In the early 1990s, scientists discovered two new species of mammals. Both was found in the isolated and mountainous Vu Quang Nature Reserve in Laos. The Vu Quang ox an ox which has long horns, is a distant relative of sheep and cattle. It was the first newly large mammal found in over 100 years. The giant muntjac, a deer with huge canine teeth, was discover soon after the Vu Quang deer. The first live specimen caught. Was a Vu Quang ox calf. It was sent to a Botanical garden in Hanoi for study.



The first new large mammals discovered in over 50 years, the Vu Quang ox and the giant muntjac, were discovered in the Vu Quang Nature Reserve (see box in illustration) in the 1990s.
