

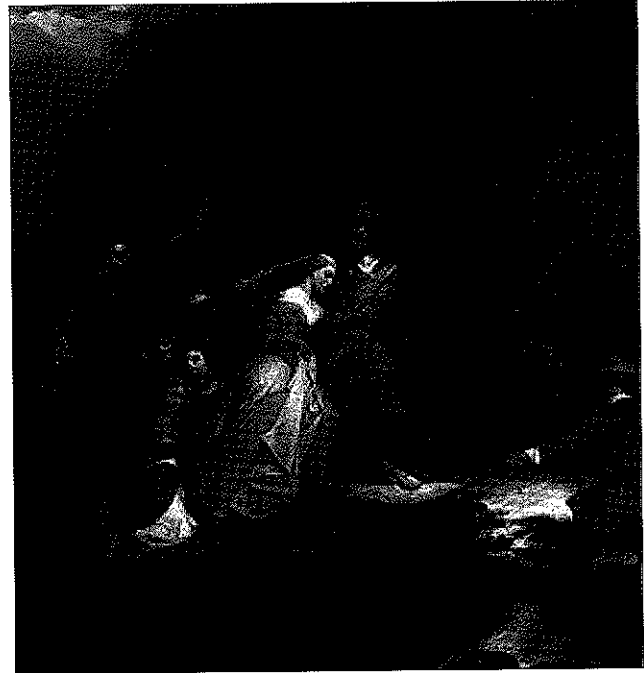
10. A New Beginning in America

Dear Elizabeth,

We have finally arrived in America after ten months aboard the *Speedwell*. We anchored along the shore of Cape Cod Bay in New York. I am afraid we may have to move again soon. We have no legal right to stay here. We expected to land farther south where the Virginia Company has given us permission to settle. I hope you are not too worried that I am hear in the great wilderness of America. I has yet to see a single Indian!
