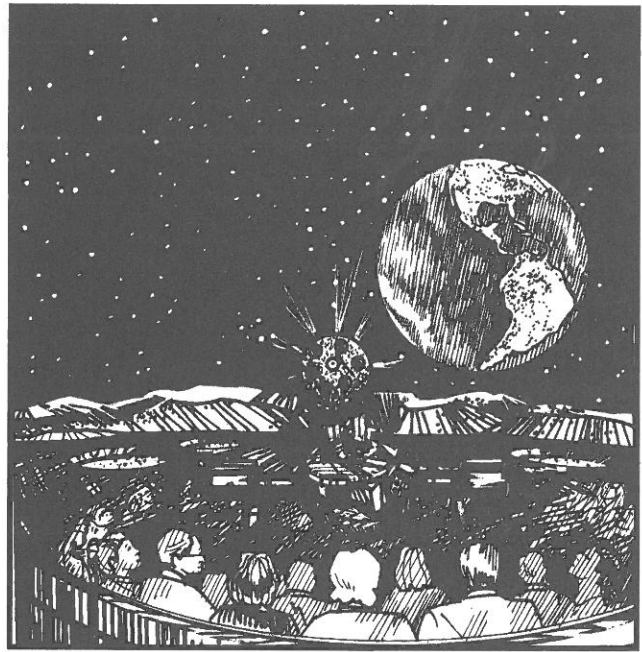


1. The Planetarium

You can expect light-years of travel during your visit to a planetarium. Special lights that are shone on the flat sealing of the planetarium simulates the movements of the stars. Music and narration help set the mood. You can enjoy an view of the present night sky, or you can see how the stars appear in the future.
