• Pathos accesses the emotions and deeply held beliefs of the audience to draw them into the subject matter.

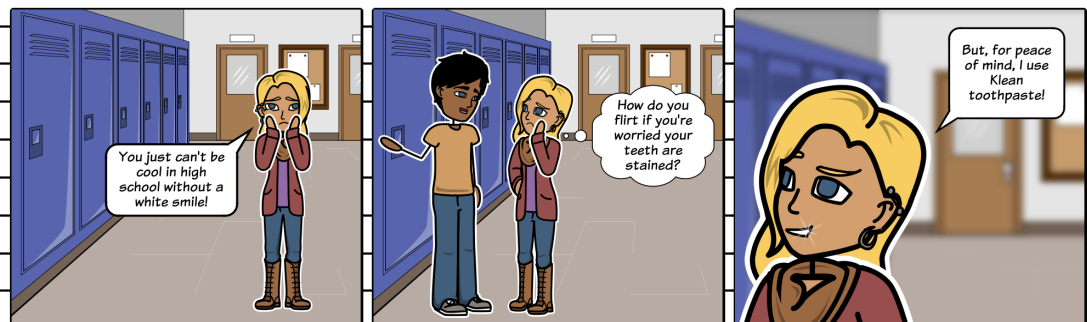
• Pathos often makes audiences feel like they have a personal stake in the information being provided.
