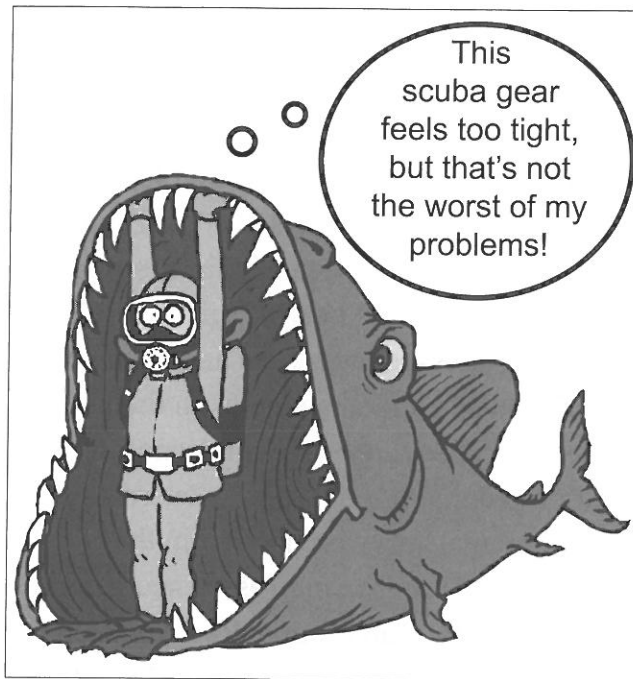


3. Fishy Story
