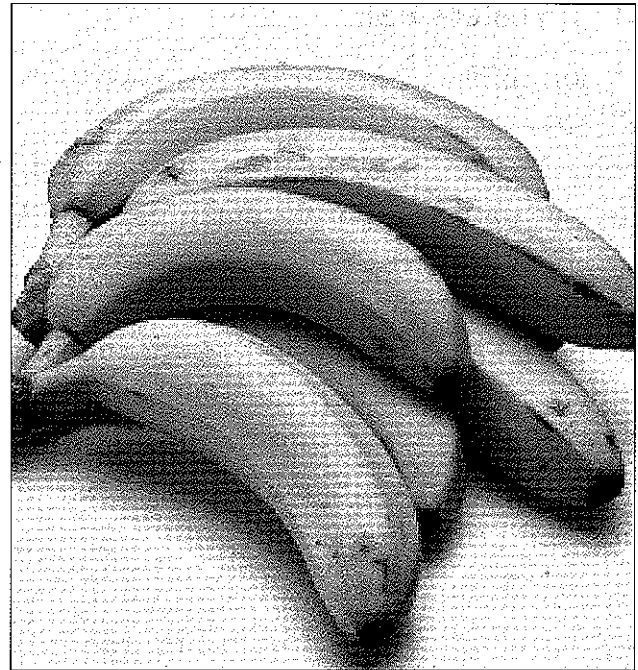


12. Bananas
