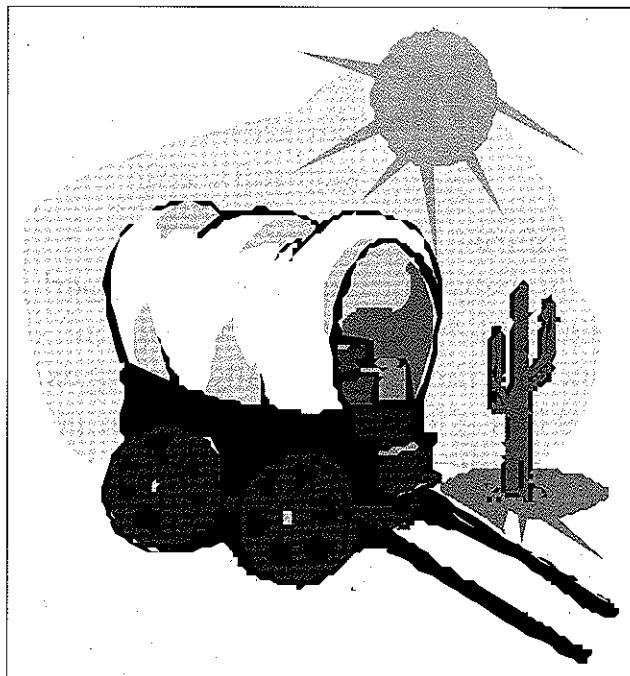


### 30. Prairie Girl
