Notes:

5 details from ch. 2:

- Scout doesn't know what to make of her 1<sup>st</sup> grade teacher, Miss Caroline.
- Miss Caroline insists that Scout stop reading at home with Atticus because he's not a licensed teacher.
- Miss Caroline tries to give Walter Cunningham a quarter so he can pay for lunch.
- Scout tells her that the Cunningham family won't take handouts from anybody.
- Scout knows about the Cunningham's because Walter's father and Atticus did some work together.

Quote from ch. 2:

"Jem, that damn lady says Atticus's been teaching me to read and for him to stop it—"

- This quote from Scout expresses her frustration with her teacher on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.
