The German Government funded development tasks in the Yocto Ecosystem, such as

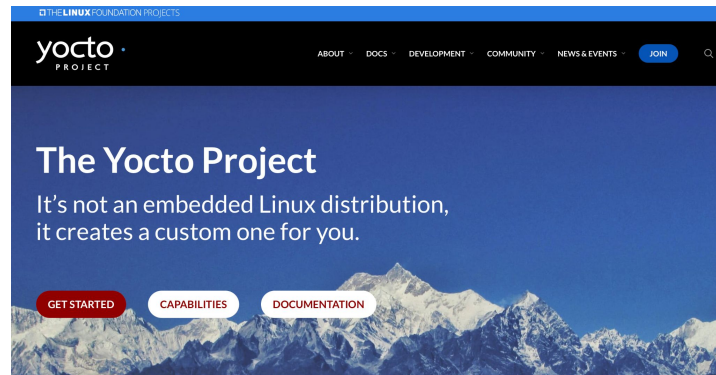
- the new VS Code Plugin

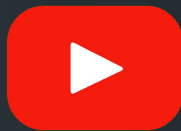
# Upcoming – OSS+ELC-E+LPC 2024
