coordinate

1. [noun] (plural) a pair of numbers that identifies a point on a graph or grid; ordered pair.
2. [verb] to arrange to work well together.
3. [verb] to order according to a common goal.

dependent

1. [adjective] relying on another for help or to provide what one needs.
2. [adjective] controlled by how something else turns out.
3. [noun] one requiring the help of another in order to survive.

independent

1. [adjective] not ruled by another; ruling oneself.
2. [adjective] separate or without connection.
3. [adjective] not needing the support or advice of another; self-sufficient.

rate

1. [noun] a quantity measured with respect to another measured quantity.
2. [noun] the condition, grade, or quality of something.
3. [noun] price or cost.
4. [verb] to regard.
5. [verb] to put in a certain rank or order.

### scale1

scale

1. [noun] one of the many small, hard, thin plates that cover fish, reptiles, and certain other animals.
2. [noun] any thin, flat piece that flakes off skin or another surface.
3. [verb] to remove the scales from.

### scale2

- [noun] (often plural) a device used for weighing.

5. [verb] to climb up or on top of.
6. [verb] to change or adjust (sometimes followed by "down").

value

1. [noun] the worth, importance, or usefulness of something.
2. [noun] the worth of something in money, goods, or services.
3. [noun] (plural) principles considered most important.
4. [verb] to set or guess the worth of.
5. [verb] to think of as important or valuable.

variable

1. [adjective] likely to change; not constant.
2. [noun] something that can change or that has no fixed value.
